## INCC Minutes October 9, 2025

- 1) Discussed the NO KINGS rally set for October 18th. INCC will host a rally for Curry County at the Gold Beach Courthouse from noon to 2:00 pm. Once again, we covered safety protocols and organization details. The rally will begin with a welcome and safety talk, gathering participants on the grass to hear the message. Safety cards will be handed out to participants and Know Your Rights cards will be available. INCC core members will wear yellow safety vests to help identify themselves as assistance providers. An information table will be set up, INCC t-shirts will be available for sale, and food bank donations will be accepted. Sign-ups continue on Mobilize sites. An open mike will be available for music and anyone who wishes to speak.
- 2) Discussed the Curry County Democrats' 2nd Community Brunch gathering, scheduled for Saturday, October 25, at the Port Orford Library, 1421 Oregon Street, Port Orford. The goal of this second brunch is to build on the ideas from the well-attended first brunch in September, using the issues and actions to organize and take planned steps.
- 3) Discussed the Card Campaign for Democracy. This organization creates cards that inform and inspire us all to stand for democracy and our rights. The cards are then printed and distributed throughout our communities. A decision was made to print one of the information cards and use the October 18<sup>th</sup> rally as an opportunity to hand them out.
- 4) An INCC member brought up the question of paying medical costs at hospitals through the Hill-Burton Act. Although none of our local facilities are covered under this act, it is a reminder that Congress has acted in a bipartisan manner in the past to benefit Americans. - 5) The next regular INCC Port Orford Rally is on Friday, October 17 (and every Friday) at the corner of 16th and Highway 101 in Port Orford from 12:00 to 1:00 p.m. We will rally on the 17<sup>th</sup> in support of No Kings.

- 6) Next INCC Information/Organizing Meeting – Thursday, October 23 (and every Thursday), at the Port Orford Library – from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm.

## ACTION ITEMS

### 1) **Continue to call or email your Senators to encourage them to stand firm on the government shutdown.**

A partisan debate over whether and when lawmakers should act to extend subsidies for the Affordable Care Act (ACA) marketplaces led to the current government shutdown. Some [24 million people](#) — who don't have insurance through their jobs or a public program like Medicaid — use the system to buy health plans. Prominent Republican lawmakers have claimed the Democrats are looking to provide tax dollars to help pay for the health care of undocumented immigrants. That is [not true](#).
