INCC Minutes December 18, 2025

- 1) Discussed the Monday Community Dinner – Numbers are up once again – 43 meals were served. Volunteers continue to step up to help – discussed the need to recruit more people who would plan out a dinner meal and serve as lead cook – with support. Half page flyers were distributed to Driftwood. We're hoping for more family participation, especially during the school's Winter Break. A volunteer sign-up form was discussed and will be created. This form will be available at each Monday dinner.
- 2) Discussed updated information on both Newport and Waldport ICE activity. A suggestion was made to send a thank-you to the Alsi Resort in Waldport for their refusal to sign a contract to house ICE workers. We will include this in Action Items.
- 3) The Port Orford Feral Cat program was discussed. INCC members voted unanimously to donate to this program via our neighbors, Happy Tails Pet Supplies. This will be included in Action Items.
- 4) The next INCC Information/Organizing Meeting – Thursday, December 18, at the Port Orford Library – from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. **There will be no meetings on Thursday, December 25 or Thursday, January 1.**
- 5) Port Orford Rallies continue every Friday at the corner of 16th and Highway 101 in Port Orford from 12:00 to 1:00 p.m. **There WILL be rallies on Friday, December 26, and Friday, January 2.**

ACTION ITEMS

Monday, December 22 - Join us for the Community Dinner from 5:00 to 6:30 PM at the Senior Center, 1536 Jackson St., Port Orford. Sign up on the volunteer form available at all Monday dinners. We are specifically looking for people interested in planning a meal and serving as lead cook for that meal, **with plenty of support.**
