INCC Minutes January 8, 2025

- 1) Discussed the Monday Community Dinners – There is some concern about continuing the dinners without creating burnout among INCC members. It was decided to try and form a committee that would include community members who would hold planning meetings outside of the regular INCC meeting schedule. For this coming Monday, the dinner will be planned in the usual way, sending a text message to our volunteer list.
- 2) Discussed the Merkley Town Hall – scheduled for Saturday, January 10 at 6:00 pm at the Driftwood Elementary gym.
- 3) Discussed the multitude of rallies and meetings planned during January in response to the war on Venezuela and ICE shootings. INCC decided to host a rally on January 17 AND January 20, as well as our regular Friday rallies in Port Orford.
- 4) Melissa Bird has filed as a candidate for State Representative, District 4. (Val Hoyle's seat.) Melissa would like to speak to INCC. Members are open to this opportunity. There was a discussion on whether this should take place at one of our meetings or if we should schedule a separate time. Because of time constraints, the discussion was tabled until our next meeting.
- 5) The next INCC Information/Organizing Meeting – Thursday, December 18, at the Port Orford Library – from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. **There will be no meetings on Thursday, December 25 or Thursday, January 1.**
- 6) Port Orford Rallies continue every Friday at the corner of 16th and Highway 101 in Port Orford from 12:00 to 1:00 p.m.
There WILL be rallies on Friday, December 26, and Friday, January 2.
