

The Bridegroom's March of Days (The 4th Hallelujah); in 4/4 march. Begun 12/25/24, released after 4/1/25 (Crucifixion Day) by BWH. The 1st Hallelujah, in 6/8 waltz, was released on 12/11/1984 by Leonard Cohen.

In Thanksgiving it is brought to remembrance, by the two blood covenants of the *two witnesses*, that the leaven of the kingdom of God, the Holy Spirit, by grace through faith, replaces the leaven of sin, unto Life. For the feast for the harvest of souls, there's the OT 4 *species* of NT *fruits in their seasons*: 1) Persian willow catkins, 2) Myrtle berries, 3) Palm dates, and 4) Citron etrogs. Note: The 2nd and 3rd Hallelujahs are for Christmas and Resurrection Day. Pronunciation; tall-Antalya.

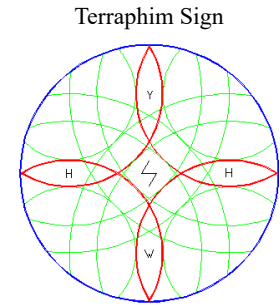
For we be-lieve the in-spir|ed Song|,

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The original song elicits the wretchedness of the breaking (spiritual death), the rending (gendered mortal souls), and the incarnation (natural depravity), but the resolution is baffled. Salvation by faith in Jesus Christ gives all grace for all previous sins; and abiding further provides 3 measures of grace (meal) for 3 feasts (septums), as the measures of grace replace the wages of sin, as one returns, in agape' Love. The first 3 septums are 3x7=21 created generations, plus the 4th septum =4 hells +3 Godhead =28; a heaven' of heavens, like the rungs of Jacob's ladder. That's like the lunar cycle of 27 days +1 (2.5 days) =28. The 4 Hallelujahs also praise God for 4 works of the Spirit in 4 historical movements; likewise praise for the 4 generations of the 2nd birth, from glory to glory in the regeneration of our spirit bodies, as God extends His glory to His faithful children (though He doesn't share His glory with any false god).
