Concept: *Sherlock Holmes has lost his pipe and cannot solve his Big Case without it. It is up to OCYSO to help Mr. Holmes recover his pipe while unlocking the mysteries of the orchestra.*

The object of using Sherlock Holmes is to focus children's attention on short bursts of educational information about the orchestra in a presentational style. This will also serve to inspire the children through a fascinating fictional character based on literature, encouraging active listening dispersed with various short activities:

- Introduction to the various instruments and sections of the orchestra;
- How an organ works;
- Activities: Clapping of rhythm and dynamics,
- Terminology and Concepts: **Tone Poem, Conductor, Composer, Fugue, Symphony.**
