Keystones: Nature's Most Important Species

The film is part of a nature series that explores the plants and animals that hold ecosystems together. Season 1 begins with ***Dog Wars – Life and Death in a Prairie Dog Town***, where underground burrows, complex social bonds, and relentless predators key the prairie dog's role as both prey and provider. ***Giants of the Sonoran*** centers around the iconic saguaro cactus, a desert giant that offers food, shelter, and nesting sites to birds, mammals, reptiles, and insects. In ***Bison – Feel the Thunder***, America's national mammal endures blizzards, predators, and competitors, maintaining the fragile grasslands for birds, insects, plants, and countless others.

Together, these stories highlight nature's intricate balance—and hint at what is lost when keystone species vanish. Season 2 promises more keystone tales to come.
