The year 2025 marked a transformative period for Apex Development Foundation as we expanded our global reach, deepened strategic partnerships, and demonstrated the power of innovation-driven development. Operating across Tanzania, Malawi, Liberia, Uganda, Nigeria, Zimbabwe, India, and Colombia, we have solidified our position as a trusted partner in advancing the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.

Under the leadership of Founder and CEO Robert M. Pontrelli, Apex Development Foundation leveraged its UN ECOSOC Special Consultative Status to mobilize resources, forge bipartisan partnerships, and deliver tangible results. From rapid humanitarian response to Hurricane Melissa in Jamaica to planning major global forums at UNGA80, our work continues to demonstrate that effective development requires both local roots and global vision.

Humanitarian Response & Disaster Relief

Hurricane Melissa Relief Initiative (Jamaica)

In response to Hurricane Melissa's devastating impact on Jamaica, Apex Development Foundation mobilized a rapid, comprehensive relief effort demonstrating our capacity for emergency response and sustainable recovery solutions.

Key Accomplishments:

- Coordinated deployment of 1,200+ solar panels through partnership with Good Sun Solar
- Mobilized medical equipment from hospitals across Upstate New York and NYC
- Secured off-grid battery systems and inverters for sustainable energy access
- Established portable clean-water systems powered by solar technology
- Collaborated with Permanent Mission of Jamaica to UN for efficient logistics and delivery

Digital Transformation & Youth Engagement

National Youth Dialogue (Tanzania)

Partnering with Kijana Initiatives Organization, Global Peace Foundation Tanzania, and Restless Development, Apex co-organized the National Youth Dialogue on Integrity and Democracy in the Digital Era on October 10, 2025. This virtual forum brought together youth leaders, policymakers, and civil society to address critical challenges at the intersection of technology and democratic participation.

UNGA80 & G-30 Forum Leadership

Apex Development Foundation will co-moderate the UNGA80 G-30 Forum, positioning youth voices at the center of global governance discussions. This represents a milestone achievement for our organization and validates our approach to youth-led development.

Worldwide Digital Revolution Summit

Planning is underway for a major summit at UN facilities focusing on digital transformation, connectivity, and bridging digital divides in underserved communities. This initiative builds on our WSIS+20 networking success and partnerships with billion-dollar organizations.

Apex Global Connect Expansion

With strategic partner iamthecode and CEO Lady Marième Jamme, we will scale our digital skills training programs across our eight operational countries, focusing on women and girls in underserved communities.

Mexican Market Entry

Exploration of Mexican expansion includes:

- Solar panel training programs for Mexican workers
- Potential Civil Association establishment
- Strategic deployment of 350 solar panels currently in storage
- Hybrid revenue model: sales, training, and donations

Water Accessibility Scale-Up

Building on successful water projects in Uganda, Malawi, and Zimbabwe, we will expand community water access initiatives across Africa with comprehensive water quality monitoring and sustainable governance models.
