Application fee : KRW 30,000

2. Application Check & Document Screening

Translation requirement: All documents written in languages other than Korean or English must be accompanied by an official translation and a notarized translated copy; failure to submit may render the application ineligible.

Evaluation Method

Document screening only (Documents 100%). If no grounds for disqualification are found, the application will be approved for admission.
