IndusInsight 2025 Symposium aims to lay a foundation to fulfill Speciality Specific Needs

A. Hematology, Oncology, Cellular Therapy

Local Needs (Karachi)

- Access to biologics and targeted therapies (often cost-prohibitive or unavailable)
- Standardized treatment pathways and algorithmic protocols
- Training on complex regimens, e.g., CAR-T readiness, transplant protocols
- Guidance on toxicity management (Cytokine Release Syndrome, ICANS, immunotherapy toxicity)
- Support in establishing clinical trial capacity
- Exposure to tumor boards and multidisciplinary care models

What US Hem/Onc Physicians Can Offer

- Protocol sharing and standardization beyond NCCN - practical workflow pathways adapted to resource-limited settings
- Case-based tumor board collaboration (virtual monthly boards: leukemia, lymphoma, solid tumors)
- Toxicity-management training workshops
- Help setting up a Quality program: CIBMTR-like reporting, transplant readiness criteria
- Collaboration for research projects, registries, and retrospective studies
- Connections with pharma for compassionate use / expanded access pathways
- Training young physicians through observerships and short-term rotations

B. Neuroscience, Neurology, Neurosurgery

Local Needs

- Modern stroke pathway design (door-to-needle times, thrombectomy logistics)
- Neurocritical care training
- Epilepsy monitoring unit setup
- Neuroimmunology diagnostics (MS, NMOSD, MOGAD)
- Spine surgery innovation and peri-operative protocols
- Research collaboration in neurodegenerative diseases

What US Physicians Can Offer

- Stroke protocol blueprint adapted for Karachi hospitals
- Support to develop or improve Neurocritical Care Units
- Training sessions on advanced neurosurgical techniques (videos, workshops)
- Consultative support for establishing EEG monitoring and epilepsy programs
- Collaboration on neurodegenerative disease research, biobanking, and data analysis
- Virtual case conferences with US neurology and neurosurgery faculty

C. Pulmonary & Critical Care Medicine

Local Needs

- Protocols for sepsis, ARDS, and ICU triage
- Ventilator-management training
- Establishing or expanding bronchoscopy and EBUS programs
- Pulmonary hypertension management pathways
- Sleep medicine expansion (underdeveloped in Pakistan)

What US Pulmonology/CCM Physicians Can Offer

- Critical care protocols adapted to Karachi's resource environment
- Ventilator-simulation workshops (virtual or onsite)
- Guidance for building a formal ICU curriculum
- Training for bronchoscopy / EBUS with remote mentorship

D. Nephrology

Local Needs

- Dialysis unit optimization
- Access to new CKD and HFpEF drugs (SGLT2 inhibitors, mineralocorticoid antagonists)
- Transplant immunosuppression protocols
- AKI management pathways
- Peritoneal dialysis expansion models

What US Nephrologists Can Offer

- Standardized AKI bundle, dialysis initiation criteria
- Peritoneal dialysis training modules
- Quality improvement ideas for dialysis centers
- Immunosuppression and transplant-follow-up pathways
- Consultation on establishing vascular access programs

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
