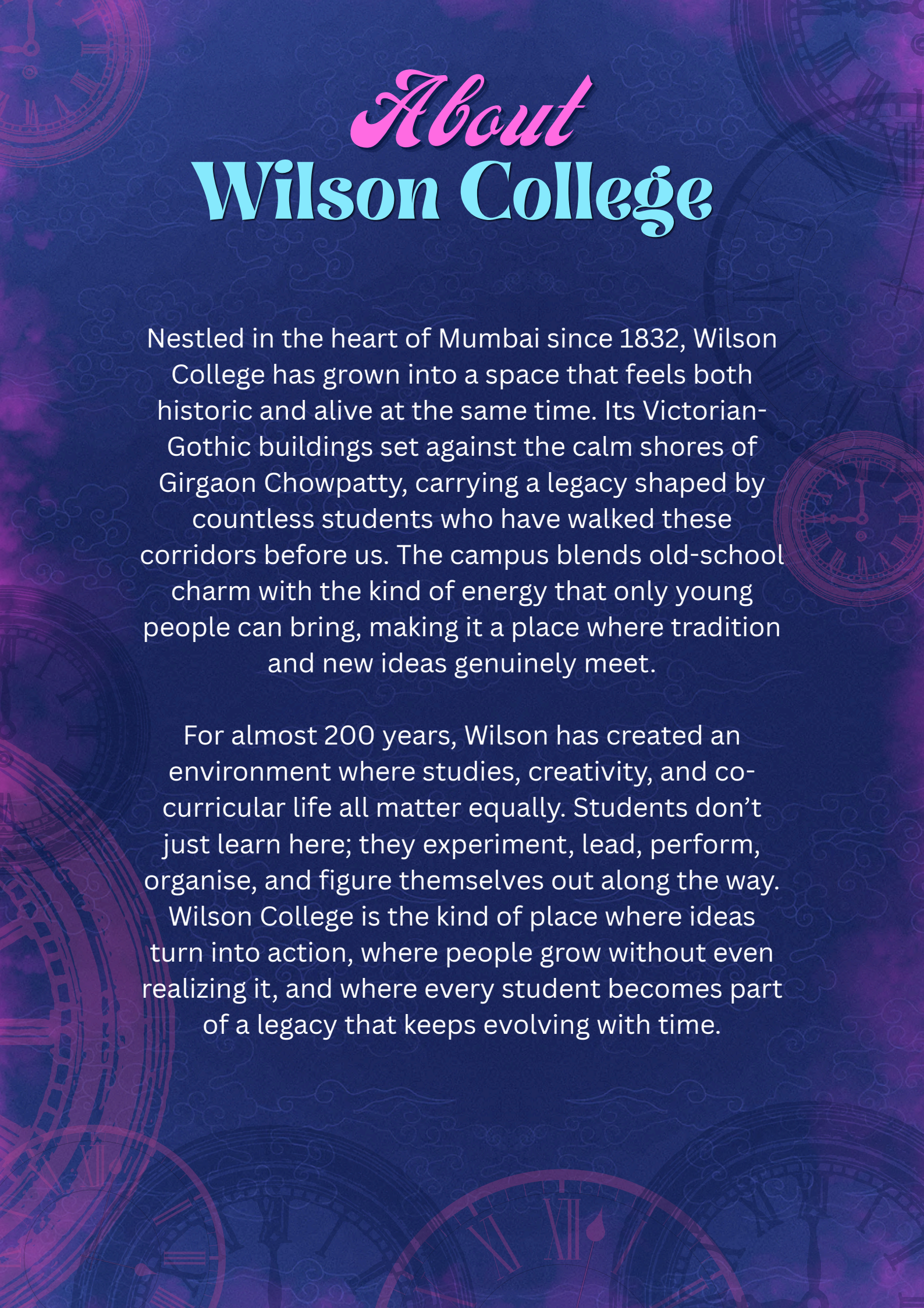

Rules and Regulations

Technicals

- Performers must submit their tracks at the Technical Junction through the in-charge volunteer 1 hour before the event.
- Music files (MP3 format) must be brought only on pen drives Both the pen drive and audio file must both be labelled as:
 - For CC- Contingent name and Event name
 - For NC- Your name, Event and College name.
- The pendrive must include the allotted POP number given during registration.
- Each pen drive must contain only one event audio file.
- No tracks will be accepted after the given time slot or once performances begin.
- Any viruses in the submitted pen drive will require the responsible participant or contingent to pay for the repair.
- Any damage caused to devices or the technical setup will be charged to the responsible contingent.
- The responsibility of submitting and collecting the participant's pen drive lies solely with the participant or the respective CL. Pen drives must be collected within one hour after the event ends. Technicals will not take responsibility for lost drives.
- Team OLE is not responsible if the track is not submitted on time.

Rules and Regulations Security

The following rules are mandatory for all participants, attendees, guests, judges, and contingents. Entry into the campus implies acceptance and strict adherence to these regulations.

1. Identification & Entry Guidelines

- All participants must carry a valid college ID card to gain entry.
- ID cards must be original and duly attested or signed by the respective Principal.
- Participants who have lost their ID cards must be accompanied by the Contingent Leader (CL) of their respective college.
- Entry to the fest will begin at 8:00 AM and close at 4:00 PM for the audience on both days.
- Participants may enter the campus only at their respective event timings and are required to report at least 1 hour prior to their event.
- The organisers and security personnel reserve the right to deny entry at any stage if rules are violated.

Rules and Regulations

Security

2. Wristband & Security Protocol

- Upon entry, all attendees will be issued a wristband, which must be worn at all times inside the campus.
- Failure to retain the wristband may result in removal from the campus premises.
- All individuals will be frisked and undergo security checks, including during re-entry.
- Organisers and security personnel hold final authority regarding entry, conduct, and safety on campus.

3. Prohibited Substances & Items

- The following items are strictly prohibited inside the campus:
- Substances & Consumables
- Alcohol
- Drugs, narcotics, syringes
- Cigarettes, e-cigarettes, vapes, cigars, or any form of tobacco
- Food, beverages, and edibles
- Medicines (permitted only with a recent medical prescription)
- Weapons, Tools & Hazardous Objects
- Matchboxes, candles, incense sticks

Rules and Regulations

- Razors, blades, needles, pocket knives, Swiss knives, or sharp objects
- Lasers
- Geometry or dissection boxes
- Flammable materials
- Chemicals or substances that may cause harm
- Personal & Miscellaneous Items
- Perfumes, deodorants
- Condoms or other inappropriate objects
- Expensive jewellery or watches
- Broken or unsafe makeup products

4. Props & Event Materials

- Participants must submit a list of all props/items a day prior to the event.
- Only items mentioned and approved in the submitted list will be allowed. Any unlisted or prohibited items will be confiscated as per security rules.
- All event materials must be collected immediately after the performance. The organising team shall not be responsible for loss or damage of materials left unattended.

5. Wait List & Special Approvals

- All CC participants carrying props or makeup must inform the PR Department by 17th January 2026.
- Only items registered within the given deadline will be permitted and checked during the fest.
- Requests made after the deadline will not be considered under any circumstances.

6. Code of Conduct

- Consumption or possession of alcohol, drugs, or hazardous substances will lead to immediate denial of entry, and the respective contingent shall face consequences.
- Verbal abuse, physical abuse, name-calling, or harassment of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Inappropriate or vulgar behaviour in any form is strictly prohibited.
- Damage to college property, misconduct, or indiscipline will be treated as a serious offence and will lead to strict disciplinary action.
- Loitering in restricted areas, classrooms, staff rooms, or offices is strictly prohibited.
- Causing crowd disturbance, blocking entrances/exits, or creating chaos near stages or performance areas is forbidden.

Rules and Regulations

Security

7. Valuables & Liability

- Attendees are requested to carry valuables at their own risk.
- Wilson College and the OLE Committee shall not be held responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to personal belongings or confiscated items.
- Reasonable care will be taken while handling confiscated items; however, the organisers shall not be liable for loss or damage.

8. Emergency & Compliance

- Any emergency must be reported immediately to the nearest volunteer or organising member.
- The organisers reserve the right to modify or update rules at any time for safety and management purposes.
- Participation in the Fest implies automatic agreement to all rules and regulations stated above.

Rules for Contingents

- All the Contingent Leaders are required to submit their final list of participants by the given dates.
- Participant Registration: After registration, the Admin team will confirm the PRNC's participation in events. Please note that filling out the registration form does not guarantee a slot for events.
- Online registrations for contingents will be open from **December 13th 2025**, subject to slot availability.
- Registration will be available on the official Olé social media pages and Website.
- NPOR – No Participation on Registration: If the participant does not show up on time for the specific event during eliminations, the contingent shall lose 100 points for regular events and 150 points for flagship events.
- NPOQ – No Participation on Qualification: If the participant does not show up for the specific event after qualifying, the contingent shall lose 200 points for regular events and 250 points for flagship events. Failure to answer the roll call at the beginning of the event will result in their registration being considered null and void.
- Successful registration for regular events will yield 50 points for standard events and 100 points for flagship events.

Rules for Contingents

- Qualification during eliminations will earn the contingent 100 points in regular events and 150 points in flagship events.
- All CLs and ACLs are required to register for the events on time. Failure to do so shall result in the contingent losing their PR points.
- It is mandatory to inform the PR team in advance to secure security permissions, especially for props and the dhol if included in the presentation.
- Contingents that participate in both online and offline PR activities, will be awarded additional PR points.
- Contingents and audience members are requested to maintain decorum while on college premises. Any misconduct may lead to negative PR points.

Guidelines

1. Social Media Account for Olé²⁶ Each contingent must create a dedicated public Instagram page for Olé²⁶.
2. Minimum Requirements:
 - At least 50 followers
 - 9 posts (or 9 reels if preferred)
 - 4 different highlights
 - 3 reels (these may be part of the 9 posts)
3. Participants must ensure the page clearly displays their contingent code and their interpretation of the Olé²⁶ theme.
4. All official Olé²⁶ social media handles must be tagged in every post or reel, and relevant fest-related hashtags must be used consistently.
5. Online engagement, including likes, followers, comments, shares, and reposts, will be taken into consideration while awarding PR points. (Spam or repetitive comments will not be counted.)
6. Any form of malpractice or forgery, such as purchasing/fabricating followers or likes, or the use of AI-generated engagement, is strictly prohibited and may lead to elimination or a major deduction in PR points.
7. Revealing your college or institution name, directly or indirectly, through logos, names, uniforms, campus visuals, or identifiable symbols is strictly prohibited and will result in significant negative marking of PR points.

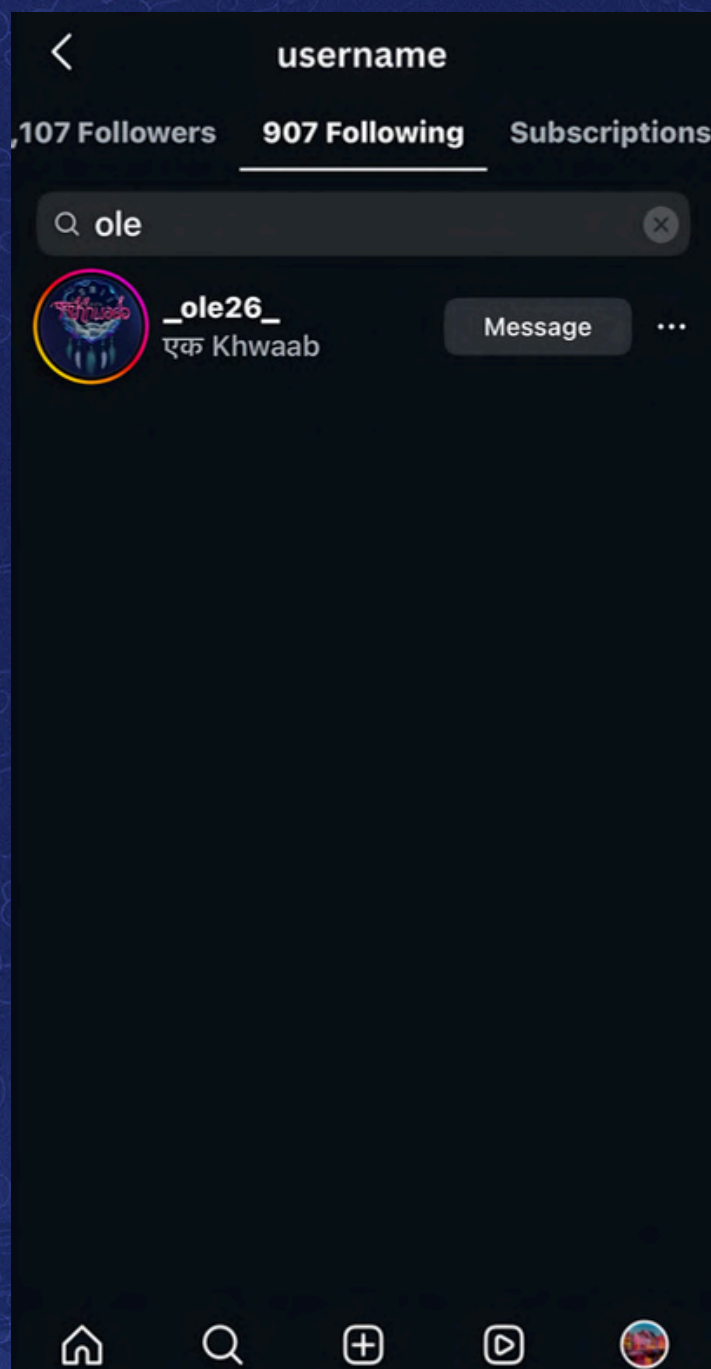
