Coupon System

The event would follow a coupon system for the steady flow of transactions between the vendors and the customers, maintaining transparency in the transactions and ease for the customers to purchase commodities conveniently.

All transactions on the stalls will happen only through coupons. The coupons will be in the denominations of Rs. 20.

The coupons will be available on coupon counters in exchange for cash payments till 5:00pm.

Coupon System

Vendors are requested to submit the total number of coupons to get their share of payments.

Volunteers will be placed between every 2-3 stalls to ensure discipline and to help the vendors as well as their customers.

The volunteers will also make rounds to ensure that no online payments are carried on.

Vendors are required to price their items according to the denominations of the coupons.

Guidelines

The rent for 6x6 stall will be ₹2500/(Kindly check layout map for reference.)


There will be an entry fee of ₹100 for alumni and any other visitors coming through reference.
