



Great Horned Owl Platform

Build base
and angled lip

Step 2
Add male mount to outside of platform




Great Horned Owl Platform



Atop a Topped Tree

Affix four 4" lag screws

Against a Trunk

Affix the female mount to the trunk with four 4" lag screws. Attach the male platform mount to female mount on the tree. Screw two 6" lag screws through the platform wall into the trunk.

Under the platform, affix at 45 degrees a pressure-treated support to the trunk with a 6" lag screw.

To the underside of the platform affix a 4" lag screw. Be careful not to puncture the base of the platform floor into the nesting area.
