Investor Brief — Infrastructure for Monetizing Expert Knowledge

The Opportunity

Across social media platforms such as Instagram, TikTok, YouTube, and Threads, millions of followers ask subject-matter experts (SMEs) highly specific questions through direct messages and comments. These interactions often require detailed, personalized responses, yet creators typically answer them without compensation.

This dynamic reveals a structural inefficiency within the creator economy: clear demand for expert guidance without a scalable monetization system.

The global creator economy is projected to approach \$480B in value, with a rapidly expanding segment of expertise-driven creators providing education, coaching, and technical guidance.

A\$Kable introduces the missing infrastructure layer that converts these interactions into structured, monetizable knowledge transactions.

The Solution

The A\$Kable App Suite transforms high-volume creator–follower interactions into a scalable digital knowledge economy.

The platform operates through two integrated applications:

1. A\$Kable Creator App

Followers submit structured questions and pay for expert responses.

AI validates question clarity before submission to protect creator time.

Creators respond through a streamlined dashboard.

2. Ask [Creator] Knowledge-Base App

Every answered question automatically becomes a searchable knowledge asset.

Followers subscribe to access the creator's growing knowledge library.

Individual responses evolve into recurring digital intellectual property.

This workflow converts one-to-one advice interactions into scalable knowledge infrastructure.

Technology Architecture

A\$nable is designed as a modular SaaS platform integrating with existing social ecosystems while maintaining independent infrastructure.

Core components include:

- AI question-clarity layer for structured expert queries
- Creator dashboard for response management and earnings tracking
- Secure payment processing and automated revenue distribution
- Knowledge-asset database indexing expert responses
- White-labeled knowledge-base applications per creator

The platform stack includes React Native, Node.js backend services, AI indexing systems, and cloud infrastructure, enabling scalable knowledge-library generation.

Revenue Model

A\$nable operates a hybrid SaaS + transaction marketplace model with three revenue streams:

1. Creator Platform Subscription

~\$25/month per creator

2. Transaction Fees on Paid Questions

Average question price: \$5

Platform take rate: ~20%

3. Knowledge-Library Subscriptions

Followers pay monthly for access to curated expert answers

Platform share: ~20%

Under baseline assumptions, each active creator generates approximately:

\$525/month (\$6,300 annually) in platform revenue.

Unit Economics

| Metric | Estimate |
|----------------------------|----------|
| Annual Revenue per Creator | \$6,300 |
| Creator Lifetime Value | \$25,200 |
| Customer Acquisition Cost | ~\$400 |
| LTV / CAC Ratio | 63 : 1 |

The platform reaches operational break-even at approximately 75–80 active creators, highlighting strong capital efficiency.

Market Entry Strategy

Initial deployment focuses on high-DM verticals where expertise demand is strongest:

- horticulture & gardening
- fitness & wellness
- financial education
- technical instruction

The Sweetlife Flora community—built by the founder—serves as the proof-of-concept market with existing demand for personalized expertise.

Expansion will follow into adjacent expert-driven verticals.

Capital Raise

Seed Round: \$1,000,000

Funding supports:

- MVP development and platform infrastructure
- internal engineering team build-out
- AI and cloud infrastructure
- creator acquisition and early market pilots

The development plan funds ~24 months of runway through MVP launch, validation, and early scaling.

Strategic Outcome

A\$kable is positioned as infrastructure for monetizing expertise in the creator economy, enabling:

- direct monetization of DM-based knowledge exchanges
- creation of scalable knowledge libraries
- recurring SaaS-style revenue streams

As creator knowledge libraries expand, the platform benefits from compounding subscription revenue and growing proprietary knowledge assets, creating a defensible and scalable marketplace for expert insight.
