**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR ACADEMIC AND CULTURAL
COOPERATION BETWEEN VISION GLOBAL GUINEA ECUATORIAL AND
THE UNIVERSITY OF INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS (UIBE)
IN BEIJING, CHINA**

ROSENDO CLEMENTE ENGONGA AVOMO, GENERAL MANAGER OF VISION GLOBAL GUINEA ECUATORIAL, and WEICHUN HAN, DEAN OF SCHOOL OF INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION of UNIVERSITY OF INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS in BEIJING, CHINA, agree to this Memorandum of Understanding.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) establishes the following:

1. OBJECTIVE OF THE AGREEMENT:

- D. Exchange of books, scientific publications, study programs, academic projects, course information, seminars, conferences and any other data and information of common interest.
- E. Develop joint research projects and joint publications in order to meet the goals of this project, **BUSINESS SKILL FOR NEXT GENERATION**.
- F. All joint activities will be realized through the mutual agreement and clearly established conditions and mutual obligations of the appropriate entities.
