## EVENT BACKGROUND



**Under India's BRICS 2026 Presidency, Global Eye Intelligence has curated "One Domain, One Month" series. This series is meant to push BRICS + practical cooperation in specific areas through focused, result-oriented discussions. The February edition focuses on Global Health and Food Security, treating them as core infrastructure for the Global South, not just as sector-specific issues or crisis tools.**

**BRICS+ countries together represent a large share of the world's population, production, and consumption. At the same time, they face similar risks: climate pressure, weak supply chains, dependence on external inputs, concentration of manufacturing, and weak data coordination. The main challenge is to move from separate national efforts to a more coordinated, system-level approach.**

**The February event looks at food security and health security as two sides of the same system-design problem. It focuses on how inputs are governed, how value chains are built, how logistics and reserves are managed, how data and forecasting are used, and how countries cooperate through institutions. The goal is practical: to agree on roadmaps, coordination mechanisms, and usable tools that make BRICS+ more resilient, less dependent on external systems, and stronger in the long term up to 2030.**

## SESSION I : SUSTAINABLE AND INCLUSIVE FOOD SYSTEMS

### IN BRICS+

### AGENDA

This roundtable, held under India's BRICS 2026 Presidency, will focus on building a shared and resilient food-system architecture across BRICS+, moving beyond fragmented national policies toward coordinated system design. The discussion will cover the full food value chain, from agro-input governance and adaptive farming practices to logistics, buffer stocks, and strategic reserves. It will examine how local and regional value chains can be better integrated, how smallholders can be included through targeted public policy levers, and how cross-border cooperation can strengthen supply-chain resilience.

The session will also define priorities for logistics infrastructure and outline a common approach to digital intelligence and forecasting for food systems, with the aim of shaping a practical BRICS+ Food Security Roadmap and shared protocols for emergency reserve management by 2030.

### PROPOSED DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What specific public policy levers should BRICS+ nations prioritize to ensure smallholders are effectively integrated into regional food architectures?
- How can BRICS+ countries align agro-input governance to balance productivity, high yields, and reduced external dependence?
- What forms of cross-border cooperation are most feasible in the short to medium term?
- How can digital intelligence and forecasting tools be shared among member states to improve transparency and crisis preparedness across food systems?
- What forms of logistics-resilience infrastructure should be prioritized for joint investment to protect the Green Spine against market shocks?

## SESSION II : STRENGTHENING PUBLIC HEALTH INFRASTRUCTURE IN BRICS+

### AGENDA

This roundtable will focus on the structural integration of public health systems across BRICS+, treating health systems as strategic capacity rather than only emergency-response tools. The discussion will cover cooperation across the full health value chain, including primary care capacity, health workforce development, regional data transparency, and interoperable surveillance systems.

The session will emphasize practical and measurable outcomes, such as shared data coordination protocols, workforce pipelines, and regional surveillance linkages, and will assess the feasibility, mandate, and priority functions of a BRICS-led Health Cooperation Body that complements existing global institutions while focusing on Global South needs. The objective is to outline a roadmap toward a more self-sustaining BRICS+ health architecture.

### PROPOSED DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Can BRICS+ build a coordination framework that complements the WHO while addressing gaps in manufacturing, financing, and system capacity in the Global South?
- What models of primary care expansion and workforce development are most transferable across BRICS?
- How can surveillance systems be better integrated across borders while respecting national sovereignty?
- What should be the mandate, structure, and priority outputs of a BRICS-led health cooperation body, and how can it support wider Global South resilience while complementing existing global institutions?



# GLOBAL HEALTH SECURITY



## SESSION III: PHARMACEUTICAL & VACCINE MANUFACTURING COOPERATION

### AGENDA

This roundtable will examine how BRICS+ cooperation can strengthen pharmaceutical and vaccine manufacturing resilience, reduce dependence on concentrated production hubs, and ensure more equitable access to essential medicines and vaccines for member states and the wider Global South.

The discussion will cover the full medical value chain, from research and development and raw materials to final production and distribution, with a focus on practical ways to improve supply security, diversification, localization, and value addition. It will also address regulatory alignment and institutional coordination as enablers of scale and reliability. A core objective of the session is to define the mandate, structure, and priority outputs of a dedicated Pharmaceutical Cooperation Working Group and to agree on what concrete results it should deliver during the 2026–2030 period.

### PROPOSED DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- How can BRICS+ countries cooperate on localization and technology transfer rather than only finished-product trade?
- How can financing mechanisms be aligned to support the high capital requirements of medical manufacturing and regulatory upgrading?
- What forms of regulatory coordination, mutual recognition, or harmonized standards are most feasible in the short to medium term?
- How can BRICS+ countries coordinate on critical inputs and APIs to reduce supply-chain vulnerabilities?
- What mechanisms can ensure that expanded manufacturing capacity translates into affordable and equitable access across the Global South?
