



JevyCO Football Leagues

Official League Rules & Regulations

1. Respect & Conduct

All players, managers, spectators, and staff must treat each other with respect, integrity, and sportsmanship.

Abusive or threatening behaviour towards players, referees, staff, or spectators will not be tolerated.

Referees' decisions are final and must be respected at all times.

2. Match Format

Matches consist of two halves of 23 minutes each.

Teams must arrive at least 5 minutes before kick-off.

Matches are played 7 vs 7.

Teams may have a maximum of 4 substitutes unless approved by the JevyCO Support Team.

3. Player Registration

All players must be registered with their team before playing.

Players must provide their name and details to the referee if issued a yellow or red card.

Players may only play for one team per season unless approved by league management.

4. Payments & League Fees

Teams signing up commit to paying the full fixed season fee.

Match fees must be paid in full before kick-off either online or in person.

No payment means no match and may result in a penalty charge.

5. No Shows & Lateness

Teams must arrive before the scheduled kick-off.

Failure to attend may result in fines, forfeits, points deductions, suspension, or removal from the league.

Repeated lateness may result in disciplinary action.

6. Discipline & Card System

Yellow Card: £5 fine.

Red Card: £10 fine.

Managers must ensure all fines are paid before the next fixture.

Failure to pay fines may result in suspension.

7. Fair Play & Player Safety

Dangerous tackles, violent conduct, or threatening behaviour will result in disciplinary action.

The league reserves the right to remove players or teams who repeatedly break fair play rules.

8. Manager Responsibilities

Managers must provide full contact details including name, phone number, and email.

League updates and disciplinary notices will primarily be sent via email.

Managers are responsible for player conduct and compliance with league rules.

9. Match Abandonment

Matches may be abandoned if dangerous behaviour occurs, players refuse referee instructions, serious rule violations occur, or safety concerns arise.

League management will determine the outcome of abandoned matches.

10. Weather & Pitch Conditions

Matches may be postponed due to unsafe pitch conditions, extreme weather, or safety concerns.

Decisions will be made by league organisers or the site manager.

11. League Authority & Disputes

The League Committee and JevyCO Support Team hold final authority on disciplinary actions, rule interpretations, match disputes, and league decisions.

All decisions made by league management are final.

12. Agreement to Rules

By registering for the JevyCO Football League, all teams and players agree to follow league rules, respect officials, and accept disciplinary actions if rules are broken.

13. Appeals Process

Appeals must be submitted within 48 hours of the match or disciplinary decision.

Appeals must include team name, player name (if applicable), match date, reason for appeal, and any supporting evidence.

The JevyCO League Committee will review the appeal and issue a final decision.
