Sasha Grynyuk is a Ukrainian-British award-winning pianist, described by Charles Rosen as “*an impressive artist with remarkable, unfailing musicality... always moving with the most natural, electrifying, and satisfying interpretations.*”

Sasha is Artistic Director of the Elgar International Music Festival in Alassio, Italy, serves as a Trustee of the Keyboard Trust and an Ambassador for the London Music Fund.

A winner of over ten international awards, he took First Prizes at the Grieg and BNDES International Piano Competitions and received the Guildhall School Gold Medal, the institution’s highest honour. Named a ‘*Rising Star*’ by BBC Music Magazine and International Piano Magazine, he has appeared at major venues worldwide. His Piano Classics recording of works by Glenn Gould and Friedrich Gulda was selected as *Record of the Month* by Piano News and shortlisted by New York Classical Radio.

Sasha’s artistic outlook was shaped through work with Noretta Conci-Leech, former assistant to Arturo Benedetti Michelangeli.
