

## China Scholarship Application Checklist (For Kenyan Students)

This checklist is designed to help Kenyan and African students prepare a complete and competitive application for Chinese Government, University, and Local Government scholarships.

## Checklist

Valid passport (at least 6–12 months validity)
Academic certificates (KCSE / Diploma / Bachelor's / Master's)
Official academic transcripts
Study plan or personal statement (China-focused)
Two recommendation letters (lecturers or employers)
English Language proficiency. A stamped letter by your previous university addressing that you completed your academics in English.
Medical examination form (Foreigner Physical Examination Form)
Police clearance certificate (Certificate of Good Conduct)
Updated CV / Resume
Research proposal (for PhD applicants)
Acceptance letter from supervisor (if required)
Portfolio (for art, design, or architecture programs)
