Eligibility.

Academic Qualification

For Master's programs: A recognized Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution.

Master's applicants: usually under 35 years (varies by university).

Language Requirement

For English-taught programs: **No** Chinese language required.

A letter from your undergraduate university to show that you completed your studies in English is required. No English tests required.

Passport Requirement

A valid Kenyan passport with at least 6 months validity.

Health Requirement

Applicants must be in good physical and mental health and submit a medical examination form.

Good Conduct

No criminal record. Some universities may require a police clearance certificate (Good Conduct Certificate issued by the DCI)

Financial Ability

Proof of ability to cover tuition and living expenses, unless applying for a fully funded scholarship.

Other Supporting Documents

Academic transcripts and graduation certificate.

Study plan or personal statement.

2 Recommendation letters.

CV (for postgraduate applicants)

East-China universities- Science and Business Masters- summary

1. Shanghai University (SHU) -Shanghai.



SHU offers several **English-taught Master's programs** in Business, Engineering, Applied Sciences, and International Relations. The university is known for strong **research output** and has multiple international collaborative labs. SHU's International College handles over **4,000 international students**, making it one of Shanghai's most diverse universities.

Eligibility: Bachelor's degree, foreign passport, meet language requirements for English/Chinese programs.

Application fees: RMB 800.

Documents: passport copy, degree certificate, transcripts, study plan/research proposal, recommendation letters, medical form, proof of language proficiency (if required).

Tuition (Master's): depends on program; ranges often **~20,000–45,000 RMB/yr** for taught programs (subject dependent).

Scholarships: university scholarships and Chinese Government (CSC) and provincial scholarships available for eligible applicants.

2. Donghua University (DHU)- Shanghai



DHU is nationally recognized for **textile engineering and fashion**. Ranked among China's top textile universities. Offers English-taught Master's programs including **MBA, International Business, Textile**

Engineering, and Materials Engineering. DHU has partnerships with **over 100 universities worldwide**, supporting exchange and dual-degree programs.

Eligibility: Bachelor's; specific programs (MBA / MSc) have degree and language requirements.

Application fee: RMB 800.

Documents: passport, degree and transcripts (translated if needed), recommendation letters, study plan, medical form, language test if required.

Tuition (Master's business/tech): example MBA and other masters commonly **~40,000–50,000 RMB/yr** (varies by program).

Scholarships: available (university scholarships, sometimes program-specific).

3. **East China University of Science and Technology (ECUST)** -Shanghai

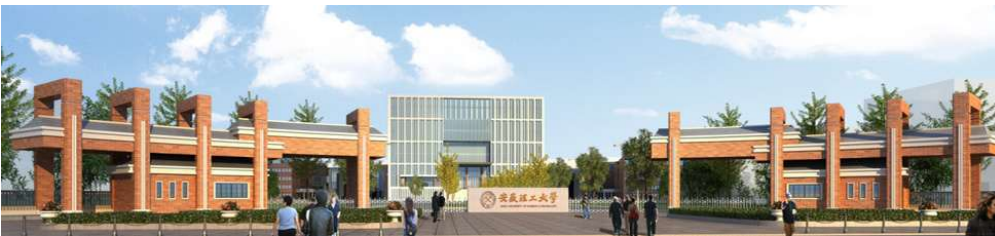

Eligibility: Bachelor's; many English-taught Master's in finance, accounting, engineering and business.

Documents: passport, diploma, transcripts, CV, study plan, references, language proof, medical form.

Application Fees: RMB 800

Tuition (examples): Varies by program.

Scholarships: XMU offers university scholarships, CSC, and program scholarships.

23. Jiujiang University (JJU)- Jiujiang, Jiangxi

Tuition: program pages show program-specific fees (most business masters ~20k–40k CNY/year).

Scholarships: university scholarships and CSC options for eligible students.

25. Jiangxi Normal University (JXNU)- Nanchang, Jiangxi



Recognized for programs in **Education, Psychology, and Natural Sciences**. Offers **English-taught Master's in Education, Business, and Languages**. Has multiple national-level teaching and research centers.

Eligibility: Bachelor's; English-taught Master's in business and education disciplines.
