

Joint Cooperation Protocol

Between

## Preamble

Based on their mutual interest in enhancing academic cooperation, scientific research, and the exchange of expertise, both parties have agreed to establish a framework for collaboration in the fields of education, training, and scientific research.

Article One: Objectives of Cooperation

Strengthening joint academic programs, workshops, and training courses.

Promoting faculty and student exchange.

Participating jointly in academic conferences and publishing research articles.

Developing strategic frameworks for mutual recognition of credits, degrees, and certificates.

Article Two: Areas of Cooperation

## 1. Joint Training Programs:

Designing and implementing short- and long-term joint academic and training programs.

Awarding joint certificates approved by both institutions.

## 2. Exchange Programs:

Academic exchange for faculty, researchers, and students.

Participation in virtual classes, seminars, and e-learning opportunities.

3. Research & Scientific Projects:

Joint research projects in mutually relevant fields.

Co-authoring and publishing articles in peer-reviewed international journals.

Supporting capacity building programs.

4. Technology and Teaching Development:

Exchanging educational resources, electronic platforms, and teaching technologies.

Collaborating on curriculum development and teaching methodologies.

Article Three: Terms and Conditions

- 1. The protocol shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of signing and may be renewed by mutual consent.
- 2. Any specific points not covered herein shall be handled through additional agreements.
- 3. All joint programs shall adhere to the academic and ethical standards of both institutions.
- 4. Evaluation and review processes shall be held regularly to ensure quality and effectiveness.
- 5. The official language of communication shall be English.

Article Four: Governance and Implementation

- 1. A joint steering committee shall be formed, composed of two representatives from each university, to plan, monitor, and evaluate activities.
- 2. Annual reports will be submitted to the leadership of both institutions. The protocol shall be reviewed every two years.

Article Five: Termination

Either party may terminate this protocol with a six-month prior written notice. The termination will not affect ongoing programs or pre-agreed obligations.
