

1. Data controller

In compliance with the applicable personal data protection regulations, users are informed that the personal data provided through this website will be processed by:

Danae Urogenomics S.L. will process personal data in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation, Spanish Organic Law 3/2018 on Personal Data Protection and guarantee of digital rights, and any other applicable regulations.

2. Personal data that may be processed

Danae Urogenomics S.L. may process personal data voluntarily provided by users through the forms enabled on the website, by email or through other contact channels.

Such data may include:

- full name;
- company, hospital, laboratory, institution or organization;
- position or professional profile;
- professional email address;
- telephone number;
- country;
- area of interest;
- content of the message sent;
- any other information voluntarily included by the user in their communication.

The website may also collect certain technical browsing data, such as IP address, cookie identifiers, device type, browser, pages visited or usage statistics, in accordance with the Cookie Policy.

3. Purposes of processing

Danae Urogenomics S.L. may process users' personal data for the following purposes:

3.1. Management of information requests

To handle queries received through forms, email or other contact channels, including requests for clinical, scientific, technical, corporate or commercial information.

3.2. Contact with healthcare professionals and laboratories

To manage communications with healthcare professionals, hospitals, diagnostic laboratories, research centers, distributors or entities interested in Danae Urogenomics S.L.'s technology.

3.3. Contact with investors and strategic partners

To handle requests related to collaboration opportunities, investment, licensing, distribution, partnerships, clinical validation or strategic development.

3.4. Sending requested documentation

To provide users with corporate, scientific, technical or commercial documentation they have requested, such as dossiers, information about the BlaDimiR platform or documentation related to collaboration opportunities.

3.5. Website improvement

To analyze the operation, security, performance and use of the website, as well as to improve the browsing experience and the quality of its contents.

3.6. Compliance with legal obligations

To comply with legal obligations applicable to Danae Urogenomics S.L.

4. Legal basis for processing

The legal basis for processing personal data will depend on each purpose:

Managing professional contacts	Legitimate interest and/or user consent
Managing investor or partner requests	User consent and pre-contractual steps where applicable

Sending requested documentation	User consent
Analyzing website use through non-essential cookies	User consent
Complying with legal obligations	Compliance with a legal obligation

Where the legal basis is consent, users may withdraw it at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out before its withdrawal.

5. Data retention

Personal data will be retained for the time necessary to respond to the user's request and, where applicable, to maintain the professional, scientific, commercial or institutional relationship arising from such request.

As a general rule:

- data sent through contact forms will be retained for as long as necessary to manage the query;
- data relating to professional contacts, laboratories, investors or partners may be retained while there is a professional relationship or a legitimate interest in maintaining contact;
- data processed on the basis of consent will be retained until the user withdraws such consent;
- data required to comply with legal obligations will be retained for the periods required by applicable law.

Once these periods have expired, data may remain blocked for the time necessary to address possible legal liabilities.

6. Recipients of the data

Danae Urogenomics S.L. will not sell or rent users' personal data to third parties.

Personal data may be disclosed to third parties only when necessary to comply with legal obligations or to properly manage the requests received.

Danae Urogenomics S.L. may also use service providers acting as data processors, such as:

- web hosting providers;
- technical maintenance services;

- form or contact management tools;
- email service providers;
- web analytics tools, where used;
- legal, tax or technical advisors, where necessary.

These providers will process data following the instructions of Danae Urogenomics S.L. and in accordance with the contracts or safeguards required by data protection regulations.

7. International data transfers

As a general rule, Danae Urogenomics S.L. does not intend to carry out international data transfers outside the European Economic Area.

However, some technology providers used for the operation of the website, hosting, email, analytics or forms may be located outside the European Economic Area or may process data from third countries.

Where international data transfers take place, Danae Urogenomics S.L. will endeavor to ensure that they are carried out with the appropriate safeguards provided for under applicable regulations, such as adequacy decisions, standard contractual clauses or other legally recognized mechanisms.

8. User rights

Users may exercise, under the terms provided by applicable regulations, the following rights:

- right of access;
- right to rectification;
- right to erasure;
- right to object;
- right to restriction of processing;
- right to data portability;
- right to withdraw consent.

The request must clearly indicate the right the user wishes to exercise and allow the applicant to be identified. Danae Urogenomics S.L. may request additional information when necessary to verify the user's identity.

Users also have the right to lodge a complaint with the **Spanish Data Protection Agency** if they consider that the processing of their personal data does not comply with applicable regulations.

9. Data security

Danae Urogenomics S.L. will apply appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect personal data against loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration or destruction.

However, users should be aware that no system for transmitting or storing information over the Internet can guarantee absolute security.

10. Children's data

The Danae Urogenomics S.L. website is not intended for minors.

Danae Urogenomics S.L. will not knowingly collect personal data from minors. If it becomes aware that data from a minor has been received without the appropriate authorization, it will proceed to delete such data as soon as possible.

11. Commercial communications

Danae Urogenomics S.L. will not send unsolicited commercial communications without an appropriate legal basis.

12. Special categories of data
