## WEAPONS REGULATIONS AND FIREARMS QUALIFICATION

- 1. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COMPANY TO TRAIN LICENSES IN ALL ASPECTS OF FIREARMS USE AND SAFETY. The Private Officers Licensing Unit (POLU) and the Board of Police Commissioners are ONLY responsible for testing certain aspects of such training but comprehensive training and ongoing safety are the sole responsibility of the company.
- 2. A licensee is authorized to carry only handguns in a strong side hip holster approved by the Board and only if the licensee has qualified with that handgun as set out herein.
- 3. The handguns approved by the Board are as follows: .38 caliber, double action solid frame revolvers (five (5) or six (6) shot); and semiautomatics, double action only or double/single action, which are equipped with a decocker or decocker safety. This requirement limits the semi- automatics which may be carried to .40, .45, and 9mm calibers. Striker action handguns are acceptable.
- 4. The department shooting range supervisor or his/her designee may deny a licensee the opportunity to qualify if, in their discretion, they believe a person or a firearm does not meet the requirements set out herein or presents a danger to others.
- 5. All applicants seeking licensure for positions for which firearms may be possessed must qualify annually with the firearm(s) on the department pistol range and under the supervision of the department's firearms personnel. The firearms qualifications standards shall be in accordance with those established by the department.
- 6. An applicant must display the ability to safely and properly handle his/her approved firearm(s).
- 7. Any applicant who displays an inability to handle a firearm safely and properly will be disqualified from carrying a firearm.
- 8. An applicant who does not attain the minimum scores for qualification shall be given a maximum of two (2) additional opportunities to qualify. An additional fee and new Forms 5409 and 5715 P.D. are required for each additional qualification and will be scheduled by the POLU. If the applicant fails to qualify after two (2) additional attempts, the applicant will not be allowed to attempt to qualify for one (1) year from the date of the last failure.
- 9. If an applicant fails the qualification course or is dismissed due to a safety violation, they may not respond to POLU to reschedule for another session until **48 HOURS AFTER THEIR LAST ATTEMPT**.
- 10. The Form 5715 P.D. Verification of Firearms Training form must be dated no earlier than **48 HOURS AFTER THEIR LAST FAILURE/DISMISSAL**.
- 11. Licensees holding an armed license may wear their approved firearm with their uniform, unless classified as a non-uniformed proprietary private investigator, while at work and while traveling directly to and from work.
- 12. Those licensed as private security and proprietary private investigators must comply with city ordinance and state law which prohibits carrying a firearm or other weapon readily capable of lethal use into any building owned or occupied by any agency of the state government. This includes the POLU and any other office within the building or any other building occupied by the department.
