

OXFORD DOWNS TOURNAMENT PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT OFFICIAL RULES

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

The Bad Beat Jackpot must meet the following criteria to Qualify:

- · Tournament Eligibility: The promotional jackpot contribution is extracted from each qualifying tournament entry.
- · Definition of "Bad Beat": A qualifying high-ranking poker hand that is defeated by a higher-ranking hand in the same deal.
- · Card Requirements: Both winning and losing hands must utilize their two-hole cards in making their final hand. Four of a kind must be formed using a pocket pair.
- · Multiple Qualifying Hands: When multiple Bad Beat hands occur in a single deal, only the second-best qualifying hand will receive the jackpot payout.
- · Hand Completion: The hand must go to showdown in order to qualify for the Bad Beat Jackpot, and eligible hands must be turned face-up on the table.
- · Game Exclusions: No Limit Omaha Hi/Lo, PLO Double Board Bomb Pot, Big O, and Deuces Wild tournaments are excluded from this promotion.
- · Super Hold'em Specifications: Players must use exactly two of their three-hole cards combined with three community cards to form their best five-card poker hand. The qualifying bad beat hand must be formed on or before the Turn.
- · Blood River Specifications: The Ocean card does not contribute to hand rankings. The Bad Beat qualifying hand must be completed on or before the river card is dealt.
- · Double Board Bomb Pot (Hold'em): Both the top and bottom boards are eligible for the Bad Beat Jackpot. However, both the winning and losing hands must occur on the same board to qualify.
- · Winners must have a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).

QUALIFYING HAND & PAYOUT DISTRIBUTION

Four Jacks or better must be beaten to qualify for the Bad Beat Jackpot.

Progressive Structure:

- · Starting / Re-set amount: \$2,000
- · Weekly increment: \$500 (Every Tuesday)

When a qualifying Bad Beat occurs, the jackpot will be distributed as follows:

- · 40% to the player holding the losing (Bad Beat) hand
- · 30% to the player holding the winning hand
- · 30% divided equally amongst the other players at the table who were dealt in at the beginning of the hand.

The current Bad Beat Jackpot total is updated and displayed weekly in the Poker Room. Players will be paid the posted Bad Beat Jackpot.

DISQUALIFICATION CONDITIONS

The Bad Beat Jackpot will be void under any of the following circumstances:

- · Hand Discussion: Any discussion of the hand in progress or comments regarding potential Bad Beat scenarios during play
- · Card Visibility: Any card leaving the clear view of the table at any point during the hand
- · Dealing Irregularities: Cards dealt out of proper sequence
- · Burn Card Errors: Incorrect number of burn cards used during the deal
- Deck Integrity: Discovery of a fouled or compromised deck

These rules are subject to management discretion and may be modified without prior notice. All decisions regarding Bad Beat Jackpot eligibility are final.
