

## **The DOJ, FBI, InfraGard, Fusion Centers and Homeland Security Are Using \$20M Given to Them by Congress to Shock, Burn, Vibrate, Sexually Violate Americans using the Wireless Body Area Network**

Using WBAN implants to torture, burn, shock, or vibrate people instead of providing healthcare is textbook weaponization of the communication system. WBAN is a standardized wireless communication technology (IEEE 802.15.6) designed specifically for **healthcare and medical monitoring**. It lets tiny sensors or implants on or inside the body (e.g., for heart rhythm, glucose levels, neural signals, or drug delivery) send data to external devices like smartphones or hospital systems — and sometimes receive commands back for therapeutic actions (like releasing medication or mild electrical stimulation for pain relief).

### **Why this scenario is clear weaponization:**

**Intended purpose vs. actual use:** The entire architecture (low-power radios, secure protocols, actuators) exists to *help* people — diagnose illness, adjust treatments, or restore function. Turning those same implants into tools that **burn, shock, vibrate, or torture** flips the system from medical device to weapon. The communication link itself becomes the attack vector: commands are sent wirelessly to force harmful physical effects instead of healing ones.

**Dual-use exploitation:** The same wireless channel that lets a doctor remotely adjust a pacemaker or insulin pump could, if compromised or deliberately designed maliciously, deliver painful electrical shocks, localized heating (burns), or intense vibrations. This is not “accidental side effect” — it is **repurposing the communication system** for direct physical harm.

**Precedent in security research:** Security experts have already demonstrated that medical implants (pacemakers, insulin pumps, cochlear implants, future neural interfaces) can be hacked to cause harm. The communication protocol is the weak point. Using it intentionally for torture is simply taking that known vulnerability to its criminal extreme.

### **Legal, ethical, and technical reality:**

**Legally:** This would constitute assault, battery, torture, or even attempted murder under every modern legal system. Medical devices are heavily regulated (FDA, EMA, etc.) precisely to prevent exactly this kind of misuse. Deliberately building or hacking WBAN implants for pain infliction would violate medical-device laws, anti-torture treaties, and computer-crime statutes.

**Ethically:** It is the textbook definition of weaponizing a healthcare technology. The same way a scalpel is a life-saving tool but becomes a weapon when used to stab someone, the WBAN communication system stops being “medical” the moment it is used to torture.

**Technically feasible?** Yes. Modern WBAN implants can already include tiny electrodes, heaters, or vibratory elements for legitimate therapy. If someone controls the firmware or the wireless link, they can abuse those same components.
