## Road Related Issues

- 1) Storm damaged roads\_\_\_
  - a) Drainage issue at Greenwood Road discussed section where stormwater sheets off road and floods adjacent residential property. Promised resident that one or more Board members will visit to assess situation
  - b) Road care funds tentatively proposed redefining winter road care fund, then allocating enough funds for road repairs needed as a result of any storm or other damage, no matter what time of year.
  - c) Recent storm damaged areas 3-page list of roads impacted worst by recent heavy rains was reviewed for general awareness and to help assess required care
- 2) PotEd utility poles poles poorly located at Greenwood Rd and Wagon Trail Rd are finally removed, allowing roads to be widened prior to upcoming resurfacing
- 3) Carroll Construction (CC) discussed unacceptable possibility if CC fails to fulfill their contract again this year; uncertainty about their firm commitment led to considering whether other contractors could fill in if needed; as an initial inquiry, proposed asking for a quote for Cedar Hill Drive repair work

- 4) Unauthorized passageway BRA resident who has opened passageway between BRA and KFA will be contacted, to be informed it is an unauthorized entry and will be closed
- 5) Sewer project update Work halted by order of WV American Water Company
- 6) Short Drive
  - a) Lighting installation at Short Drive is waiting for delivery of pole extension
  - b) Cluster mailbox location instead of discussing by phone with coordinator during meeting, Board committed to meet at proposed site to decide installation location
- 7) Entry sign at 'Big Rock' raised letter design proposal approved; letters to be bored into rock surface and secured with vandal resistant adhesive. Cost of letters \$2,000; \$400 est. cost for installation; \$200 est. to power wash rock. Cost reduced by promised donation of power wash and 1/2 cost of sign. Acquisition deferred until 2026 fiscal year.
