Itinerary Highlights

Day 1: Dushanbe to Kalaikhum (375km)

Accommodation: Guesthouse Meals: Lunch² and dinner²

- Depart Osh and visit Norak reservoir, one of the world's largest earth-filled dams
- Visit Hulbuk Fortress ruins near Kulob
- Drive through dramatic landscapes along Panj River
- Overnight in KalaiKhumb guesthouse

Day 2: Kalaikhum to Khorog (250 km)

Accommodation: Guesthouse

Meals: Breakfast², lunch¹ and dinner²

- Scenic drive along the Afghan border
- Explore the natural fortress at Kevron village
- Visit Rushan village and traditional Pamiri houses
- Overnight in Khorog guesthouse with traditional Pamir diner.

Day 3: Khorog to Ishkashim (110 km)

Accommodation: Guesthouse

Meals: Breakfast², lunch¹ and dinner¹

- Visit Khorog Botanical Garden
- Short stop at the Dinosaur Rock
- Stop at Garm Chashma hot springs
- Overnight in Ishkashim guesthouse

Day 4: Ishkashim to Langar (135 km)

Accommodation: Guesthouse

Meals: Breakfast¹, lunch¹ and dinner¹

- Morning visit to the bustling Afghan market
- Visit the Khaakha Fortress
- Relax in the healing Bibi Fatima hot springs and explore the 3rd century BC Yamchun Fortress
- Stop at Vrang to see the ancient Buddhist stupas and the Sufi Muborak-Kadam Museum
- Overnight in Langar guesthouse



Day 5: Langar to Bulunkul (125 km) Accommodation: Guesthouse

Meals: Breakfast¹, lunch¹ and dinner¹

- Morning walk to see petroglyphs near Langar
- Drive through Khargush Pass (4344m), leaving the Wakhan corridor
- Short stop at Yashilkul Lake along the way.
- visit to serene Bulunkul Lake
- Overnight in Bulunkul guesthouse

Day 6: Bulunkul to Murghab (170 km)

Accommodation: Guesthouse

Meals: Breakfast¹, lunch¹ and dinner¹

- Discover ancient Shakhty Cave Paintings
- Explore Murghab and it's old soviet vibe
- Overnight in Murghab guesthouse

Day 7: Murghab to Sary Mogol (260 km)

Accommodation: Guesthouse

Meals: Breakfast¹, lunch¹ and dinner²

- Visit Murghab's vibrant local market
- Cross Ak-Baital Pass (4655m), the highest point of our journey
- Lunch at Karakul Lake, the highest lake in Central Asia
- Cross into Tajikistan via Kyzylart Pass (4280m)
- Overnight in traditional yurt camp near Tulpar-Kul Lake

Day 8: Sary Mogol to Osh (250 km)

Accommodation: Yurt stay Meals: Lunch² and dinner²

- Visit Lenin Peak Base Camp for stunning views of glaciers and the 7,134m peak (if weather permitting)
- Depart Osh and cross Taldyk Pass (3554m)
- Overnight in traditional yurt camp near Tulpar-Kul Lake
- Arrive in Osh, end of the expedition

Meals

To ensure our guests' health and safety, we've made some adjustments to the meal arrangements:

- In Dushanbe, Osh, and Khorog, meals will be provided by local guesthouses or restaurants.
- For all other locations along the route, our guide will personally prepare the meals for our group.

This approach helps minimize the risk of food poisoning, which can be common in remote areas of the Pamir. By taking control of food preparation, we can maintain higher hygiene standards and carefully select ingredients.

Please inform us of any dietary requirements well in advance of the expedition.

Bookings and Payment Conditions

Payments must be made in full at the time of booking unless explicitly agreed otherwise. The booking will be confirmed in writing via a confirmation email.

Cancellation

If you wish to cancel your booking, you must notify us in writing. The cancellation date is the date we receive your written notification. Cancellation charges will apply as follows:

Cancellation Charges:

- More than 60 days before departure: 15% of the total trip cost
- 60-30 days before departure: 30% of the total trip cost
- 29-15 days before departure: 60% of the total trip cost
- 14 days or less before departure: 100% of the total trip cost

You have the right to transfer your booking to another person up to 14 days before departure free of charges.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What's the best time to visit the Pamir region?

A: The ideal time for our Pamir Highway expedition is from mid-June to mid-September. During these months, the weather is most favourable, and mountain passes are typically clear of snow.

Q: How physically demanding is this expedition?

A: While our UAZ expedition vehicle does most of the hard work, you should be in reasonably good health. We'll reach altitudes up to 4,655m, so some basic fitness is recommended. Most activities involve light walking, but the high altitude can make this more challenging.



A: Altitude sickness can affect anyone, regardless of fitness. Our itinerary is designed to allow for gradual acclimatization. Stay hydrated and inform your guide if you feel unwell. Consider consulting your doctor about altitude medication before the trip.

Q: What type of accommodation can I expect?

A: We offer a mix of authentic local experiences. You'll stay in yurt camps and basic guesthouses. Facilities are often simple, reflecting the remote nature of the region. Expect shared rooms and basic sanitation facilities in some locations.

Q: What's the food like on this expedition?

A: You'll experience a mix of local cuisine and carefully prepared meals by your guide. Let us know if you have any food restrictions or allergies.

Q: Do I need a visa?

A: You may need visas for both Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan depending on your nationality. You'll also need a GBAO permit for the Gorno-Badakhshan region. We can assist with visa information and GBAO, but please check the latest requirements for your nationality.

Q: What should I pack?

A: Pack for varying weather conditions. Bring warm layers, a good jacket, comfortable walking shoes, a hat, sunglasses, and sunscreen. Don't forget any personal medications, and a camera for those stunning mountain views!

Q: Is Wi-Fi available during the expedition?

A: Wi-Fi is very limited in the Pamir region. Some guesthouses in larger towns may offer basic internet, but it's best to prepare for limited connectivity during most of the expedition.

Q: How many people are in an expedition group?

A: Our UAZ expedition vehicle comfortably seats 6 travellers plus your guide/driver. We keep our groups small to ensure a more personal experience and to minimize our impact on the local communities we visit.

Q: Is it safe to travel in this region?

A: While the Pamir Highway passes through remote areas, it's generally safe for travellers. As your guide, I'm experienced with the route and local customs. However, as with all travel, it's important to exercise common sense and follow local advice.

Q: How does this expedition benefit local communities?

A: At Borderless Expeditions, we're committed to responsible tourism. We work directly with local communities, ensuring that your visit contributes positively to the region. Your expedition helps support local economies and preserves traditional ways of life in the Pamir.
