


## Alidon Medium Shell Set (3") – Self-Lighting Instructions

---

### Alidon Medium Shell Set (3") – Self-Lighting Instructions (Sequential 8-Shell Pack – One Fuse, One Show)

 **Important:** For outdoor use only.

**Adult supervision and caution are required.**

Never attempt to modify or separate the shells.

---

#### What's Inside:

- 8 professionally matched 3" aerial shells
  - Pre-connected fuse system (fires shells one after another)
  - Safe lighting point clearly marked
- 

#### Step-by-Step Lighting Guide:

---

##### **1** Setup Area

- Use an **open outdoor space** (field, backyard, beach)
  - Keep at least **80–100 meters clear space** in all directions
  - No people, trees, power lines, or buildings overhead
- 

##### **2** Secure the Mortar Rack

- Place the included rack (or secure mortars) on **flat, stable ground**
  - Use **bricks, sandbags, or stakes** to prevent tipping
  - Ensure all shells are upright and pointing away from the crowd
- 

##### **3** Identify the Fuse

- Look for the **main fuse** marked "START HERE"
  - Do **NOT** remove or adjust the fuse chain
  - The fuse is **pre-connected** to fire all 8 shells in sequence
- 

##### **4** Lighting the Fuse

- Use a **long lighter**, portfire, or extended stick  
(Do not use matches or short lighters)
  - Stand to the **side**, not in front of the rack
  - Light the main fuse and **immediately move back 25+ meters**
- 

##### **5** Enjoy the Show

- The first shell will launch in a few seconds
- Each shell will fire automatically in order (about 5–6 seconds apart)

- Do **not approach** until all shells have fired and at least **10 minutes** have passed
- 

● **Safety Warnings:**

- Never lean over or stand in front of the shells
  - Do not relight or tamper with misfires – soak with water
  - Keep **water, sand, or fire extinguisher** nearby
  - Always keep **children and pets away** from the launch zone
  - Do not light during strong wind
-
