

# 10 Days Andalusia Xclusive Muslim Tours

## Day 1: Arrival Barcelona Airport

Immerse yourself in the Llotja de la Seda, a UNESCO World Heritage site, steeped in history and stunning architecture.





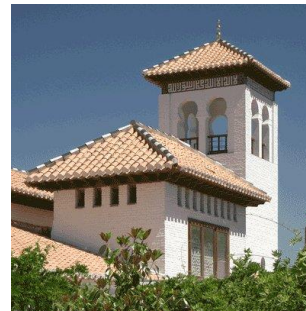
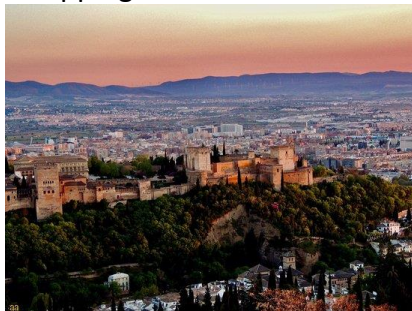
#### Day 4: Valencia > Granada

After breakfast, journey to Granada. Upon arrival, explore the capital of the last Islamic Emirate of Al-Andalus. Immerse yourself in the enchanting beauty of the Generalife Gardens and the Alhambra, a palace and fortress complex with Islam architecture dating back to the Nasrid Dynasty. #### Day 5: Granada

After breakfast, continue exploring the gems of Granada. Enjoy panoramic views at San Miguel Alto before visiting the historic Albaicin quarter. Immerse yourself in the charm of Andalusia as you wander through its ancient, white-washed houses, starting at the Main Mosque of Granada and continuing to the San Nicolas Viewpoint, which boasts breathtaking vistas of the surroundings. Discover the enchanting Plaza Nueva and take some free time to lose yourself in the narrow streets, indulging in souvenir shopping.



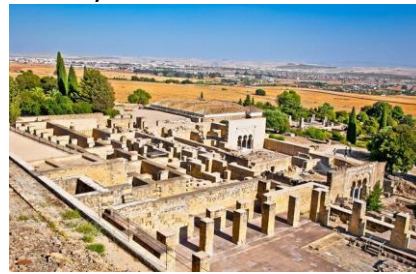
#### Day 6: Granada > Seville

After breakfast, journey to Seville. Upon arrival, explore Plaza de España and wander through Seville's historic city center, a place of profound significance in Al-Andalus, and crossed by the largest river in Andalusia. Immerse yourself in the heart of Seville, where the iconic Giralda, once the Great Mosque of Seville, stands proudly. Discover the beauty of its orange gardens and delve into the impressive Alcazar Palace and the Golden Tower, all contributing to the rich Islamic heritage of Al-Andalus.



### Day 7: Seville > Cordoba

After breakfast, journey to Cordoba. Upon arrival, explore Cordoba, the ancient capital of the Islamic Emirate of Al-Andalus. Wander through the streets of the traditional Jewish and Arab quarters, perfect for souvenir shopping and photography. Visit the Great Mosque of Cordoba, once the world's second-largest mosque after Masjid al-Haram in Mecca. Uncover the Andalusian Palace-City of Medinat Az-Zahra, a UNESCO World Heritage site, that was the extravagant seat of the Caliphate during the 10th century.



### Day 8: Cordoba > Toledo > Madrid

After breakfast, journey to Toledo, "the city of the three cultures". Partake in a panoramic tour, immersing yourself in the unique blend of Christian, Jewish and Muslim influences that have shaped Toledo's rich history. Pause for a photo stop at the breathtaking Moorish bridges of San Martin & Alcantara. Explore the renowned Sword Factory, a symbol of Toledo's craftsmanship. Wander through the old city center, visiting the well-preserved Mosque Cristo de la Luz, one of Toledo's 11 former mosques. In the afternoon, continue journey to Madrid.



### Day 9: Madrid

After breakfast, explore the dynamic city of Madrid, the only European capital with an Arabic name and Islamic background. Enjoy a city sightseeing tour by bus, including iconic landmarks such as Puerta del Sol, Plaza Mayor Square and Casa de la Panadería. Pause for a photo opportunity at the majestic Palacio Real (Royal Palace), and marvel at the bustling Gran Via, Plaza de España, Plaza de Cibeles and Plaza de Castilla. Take a photo stop at the Bernabeu football stadium of Real Madrid. Take a break with prayer at Abu Bakr Central Mosque of Madrid. Spend the last afternoon with our

guide on a shopping spree in Spain – a top-notch destination for the best and cheapest finds in Europe.
