



The cities of Fez, Meknes, Marrakech and Rabat are collectively known as the imperial cities, and have all, at some point in Morocco's history, been the capital; Rabat is the current holder. The oldest is Fez, first established as capital in the ninth century under Sultan Idriss II. After the fall of his dynasty, the Almoravides took over, and Marrakesh became their capital; but Fez remained an important city, and has been capital twice since under different rulers. Rabat, as their capital; this was replaced, during the rule of Morocco's notorious sultan, Moulay Ismael, by Meknes. Rabat again became capital under the French protectorate, which began in 1912, and retained the title after independence. The desert tour will make you explore the majestic Morocco Sahara desert to follow the paths of the old caravan roads while driving past Draa Valley with its oases dotted with dates palm trees and fortified Kasbahs cross the volcanic massif of the Anti-Atlas Mountains, ride your camel in Erg Chebbi, Sleep under the stars at your Morocco Sahara desert camp in Merzouga, cross the Valley of the roses and the road of 1001 Kasbahs. Finally, admire the splendid Kasbah of Ait Ben Haddou and arrive to Marrakech!

- Overnight at the hotel in Fez




Day 3: FEZ > ERFOUD > MERZOUGA (B, D)

- Arrival to Erfoud and switch to 4x4 vehicles for 2 hours safari tour and go through Merzouga to enjoy the sunset
- Dinner and overnight will be at your Bivouac



Day 4: MERZOUGA > OUARZAZATE > AIT BEN HADDOU (B, D)

- Early morning Camel ride excursion to Merzouga sand dunes to watch the sunrise
- Breakfast at the Bivouac, visit of Ouarzazate and departure to Ait Ben Haddou and visit:
- Ruins of ancient Kasbah
- Overnight at the hotel in Ait Ben Haddou
