The target is broken into 4 quadrants representing the US Service Branches.

Declare a service you wish to represent and only shoot that section of the target.

The white outer ring is 5 points progressively increasing to the white center worth 10 points.

Shots must be completely inside the vertical and horizontal stadia on the 5,6,7,8 and 9 rings to count for score.

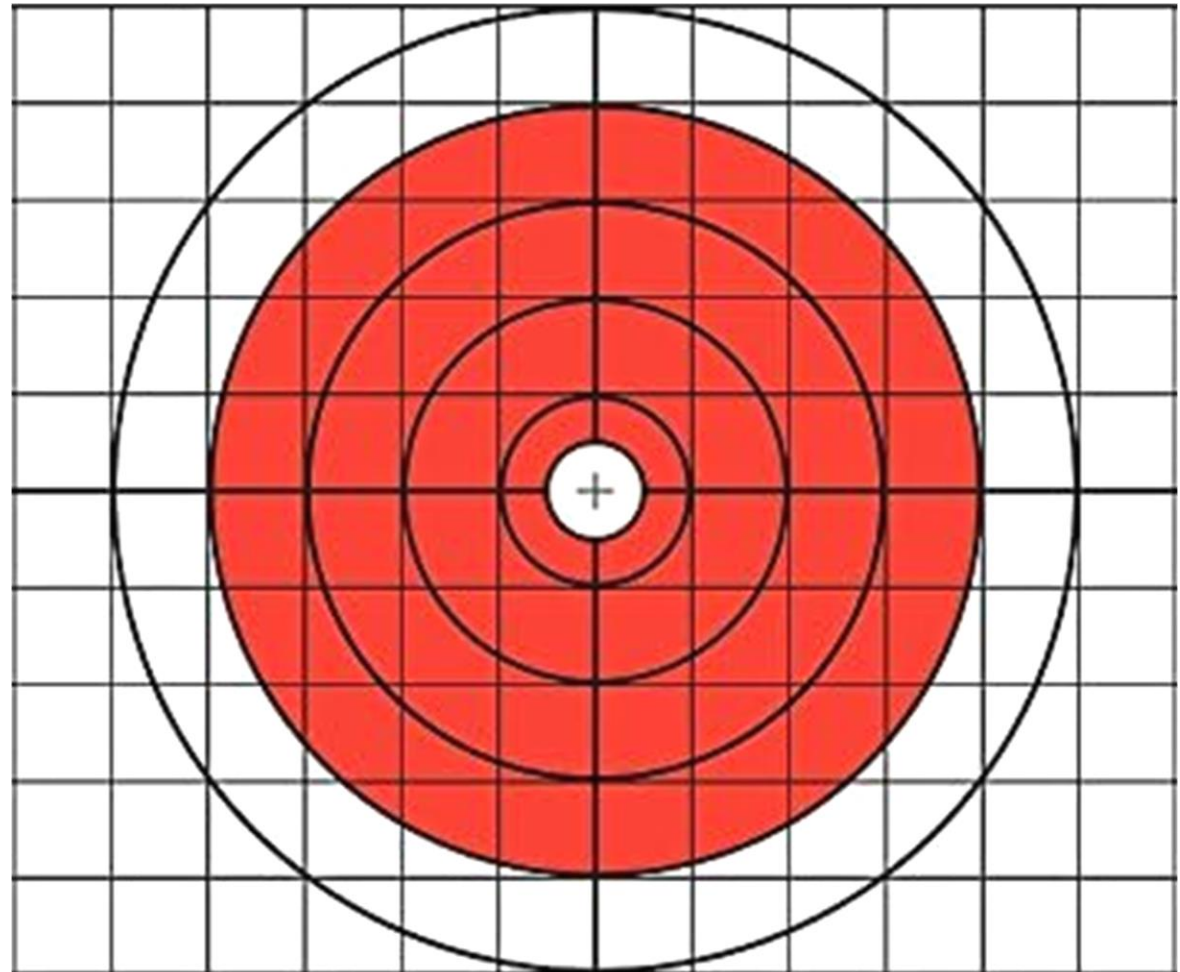
Shots that break the 10 ring in your "sector of fire" and any that go outside your quadrant BUT stay inside the 10 ring have a 10-point value.

10 shots, 50 yards, 100 possible points.
