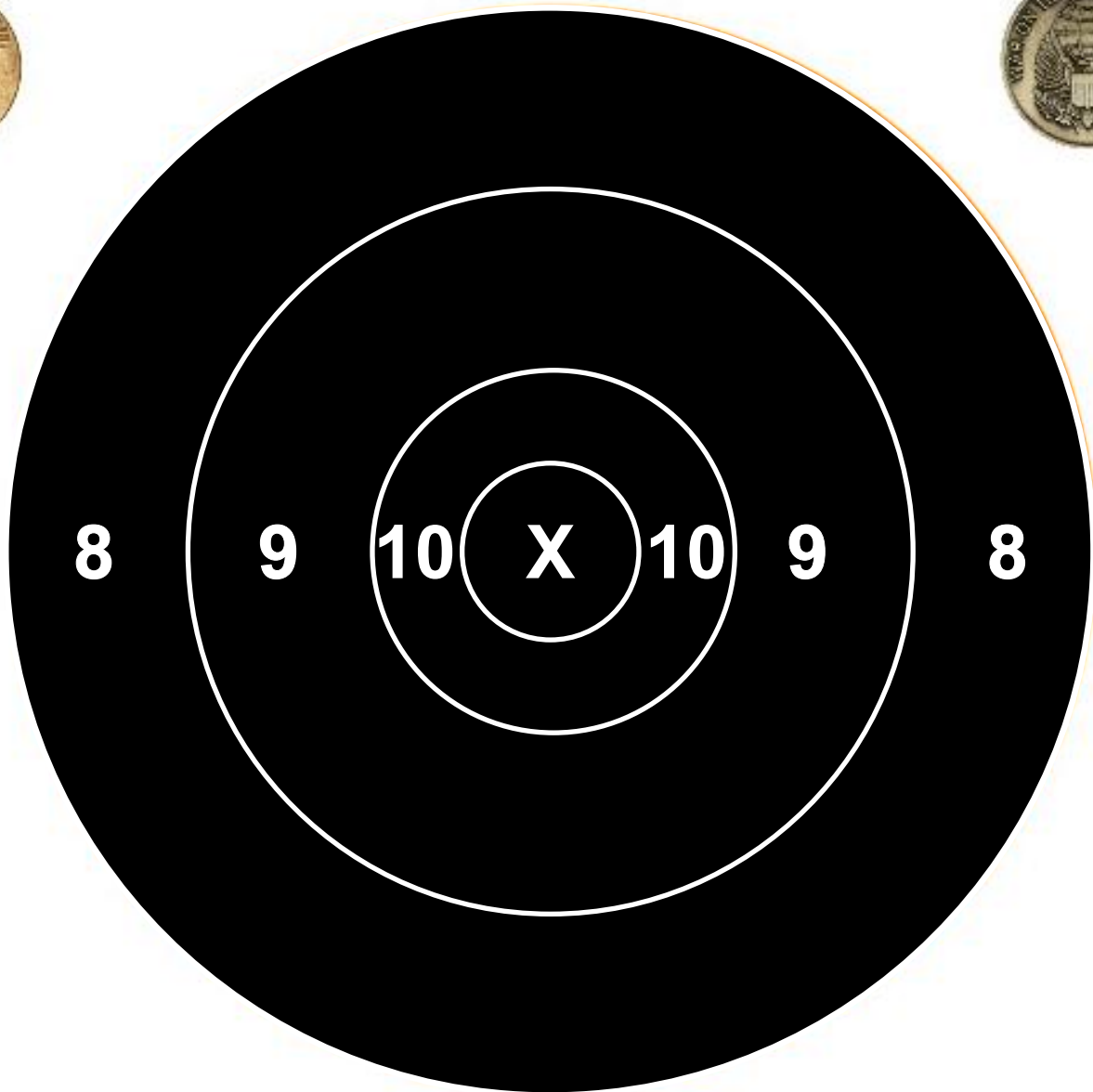


Long Rifle's 100 Yard Mil-Surp Veterans Day Challenge



Veterans Day originally observed as “Armistice Day” in 1919 recognized those who served in the “Great War” and is still observed by many Countries as such today. In 1938 it became a US Federal Holiday and in 1954 the name was changed to “Veterans Day” to be inclusive of the recent WWII and Korea era Veterans.

So dust off Grandpa’s Garand or similar centerfire rifle and get out and show your support for those who served! Rules are simple, 10 shots with a US or Allied Forces Military Surplus or modern MIL-SPEC replica with IRON SIGHTS from any position you want, you may use shooting blocks and bags for support but there will be no adjustable front rests or “sleds” allowed.
