



SERVICE STRUCTURE INSIDE THE A.A. GROUP




HOW THE A.A. GROUP FITS INTO THE STRUCTURE OF THE FELLOWSHIP (United States & Canada)

I'm challenged to believe that I'm already a second-year delegate, and will be attending my second (and final!) General Service Conference in less than two months. But yet, here I am.

To say that I'm grateful for the opportunity to serve the Fellowship that saved my life is an exquisite understatement. When I had the realization that my time as the "GSR for Oklahoma" was coming to an end at the conclusion of this calendar year, it reminded me of the value in living presently, mindfully and in God's will. Yes, I will rotate on soon enough and someone else's turn to serve will come. But until then, I am going to enjoy this once-in-a-lifetime privilege for as long as I can. So I know I've said it before, but thank you for giving me this chance to serve Area 57. It's been a true highlight of my sobriety.

I cannot wait to see everyone at the mock conference at our next Area meeting on 03/22. This important exercise is a critical one that keeps the upside down triangle functioning properly by giving the members of Oklahoma an opportunity to have their conscience heard ahead of the GSC in April. Your opinions and feedback are critical as I prayerfully consider how to vote on some of the agenda items. The mock conference is open to everyone.

I'll also give a more detailed report at the Area meeting about the goings-on in AA as a whole, but until then, here's a few highlights:

- Upcoming GSC and Mock Conference
 - The 76th General Service Conference runs 04/26 - 05/02 in NYC
 - The final agenda and background (along with mock conference material) is currently posted on our state website in the password-protected section of the delegate's page. You can email me for the password if you don't have it
 - There will be two online Sharing Sessions to give members of Oklahoman an opportunity to share their thoughts on some of the GSC agenda items. The sessions will be 03/11 and 04/12. You can find details on the calendars of any of the websites (aaoklahoma.org, Intergroup, and NECS)
 - You can view all proposed agenda items (PAIs) that were submitted last year, which also includes a disposition for those that weren't forwarded to the 76th GSC
- AA as a Whole & Finances
 - I distributed the Q4 Financial Report on 02/28. Please contact me if you have comments or questions
 - Work on the 8th floor retrofit at the General Service Office continues
 - Once the retrofit on the 8th floor is complete, the GSB Reserve Fund be approximately 5.1 months
 - AAWS will be starting Season 2 of the podcast "Our Primary Purpose". If you haven't listened to it (or to the Grapevine podcast) you're missing out!
 - Grapevine app subscriptions increased 35% in 2025, and the financial losses for GV/LV decreased from \$800K two years ago to under \$300K in 2025
 - Contributions in 2025 were down \$500K from budgeted
 - Operating Expenses in 2025 were lower than budgeted

There's definitely lots more, so come hear details at the Area meeting on 03/22.


