- Lounge Entertainment at Moderate and Deluxe Resorts:
  - Pianist at the Grand Floridian
  - Yehaa Bob Port Orleans
- Disney Resort Character Entertainment: Disney characters come to resorts to play with resort guests however there is no set schedule
- Have a Disney Visa Card? You can have a special character meet and greet in EPCOT
- Concerts during the EPCOT festivals: These concerts are most of the year and have a WIDE variety of artists from bands you grew up with, to celebrity narrators for Candlelight processional, to Broadway
- Resort Campfires: many of the resorts, specifically the Moderate and Deluxe resorts have campfires where you can roast smores BUT the Chip and Dale campfire at Fort Wilderness is the best and has lots of extras to go along with it.
- Animal Kingdom Lodge: View the animals on the multiple savannahs
- Animal Kingdom Lodge: Collect beads as you learn about Animals, Science and the Environment from culture representatives from Africa
- Play on the playground at the Disney Resorts
- Go on a Monorail crawl to see all of the resorts
- Take a boat to and from Magic Kingdom to the Grand Floridian, Polynesian, and Wilderness Lodge, and Fort Wilderness
- Take a boat along the Hollywood Studios, Boardwalk, Swan and Dolphin, EPCOT route.











- Take a boat from Disney Springs to explore Port Orleans Riverside and French Quarter
- Watch a movie under the stars at Disney Resorts

- get free collectable cards from the transportation team
- try to collect as many different Disney Stickers as possible (there are a lot of different ones that cast members have and some unique ones ie Jaminators or the Monorail)
- Get EPCOT passports for the festivals
- Get Kidcot crafts/postcards at each country in the world showcase in EPCOT. You can learn from someone from that country while collecting them all. If you collect them all bes ure to tell the cast member giving you the last one;)
- Many resorts have free activities like arts and crafts for kids (especially the deluxe and moderate)
- Club Cool: try a variety of coke products from around the world (EPCOT)











- Check for samples at the confectionary on Main Street in Magic Kingdom
- Kids under 3 eat free at Character dining at most locations
- Watch the Magic Kingdom Fireworks from outside the parks (various locations Contemporary, Polynesian beach, Grand Floridian, on the side of the ferry dock at the Transportation and Ticket Center)
- Watch the Electric Water Parade on Bay Lake/ 7 Seas Lagoon in front of Magic Kingdom (typically starts making its way around at 9pm)
- See Christmas decorations at the resorts
- Play legos at the lego store in Disney Springs
- Free art class at Art of Animation, you can get the picture from the animator at the end if you are the first to ask
- Atlantic Dance Hall (no cover evenings)
- Get pixie dust in Magic Kingdom AND/OR mickey confetti in either the barber sharp on main street or sir mickeys
- Cast Members take your picture with your camera
- wifi
- First aid and Ambulance ride (historically has been free if necessary)
- shopping delivery from the park to your resort
- Get a lai at the Polynesian Village Resort
- store your bags at the resort before you can officially get into your room and if you are transferring from one Disney hotel to another be sure to ask for luggage transfer while you're at the parks

- Get autographs from the characters, if you don't have a book the cast member will get a piece of paper for you
- Yoga classes at resorts (Art of Animation has one currently)
