For therein is the righteousness  
of God revealed from faith to  
faith: as it is written, The just

*The LORD is  
merciful and  
gracious, slow to  
anger, and  
plenteous in mercy.

*He that committeth sin is of  
the devil; for the devil  
sinneth from the beginning.

*And this is his
