WHAT DOES A COMPUTER NETWORK TECHNICIAN DO?

Network technicians and administrators are responsible for overseeing, optimizing, and protecting a company's computer network.

- Typical tasks for this role include:
- Installing network hardware and software
- Troubleshooting hardware, software, connectivity, and server issues
- Installing and configuring individual workstations
- Training users and providing technical support
- Updating software as needed
- Monitoring network security
- Performing backup operations
- Performing disaster recovery procedures
- Configuring cloud services
- Identifying ways to optimize the network infrastructure

Admission Requirements

- Minimum of a Canadian high school grade 12 or equivalent (Ontario high school diploma or equivalent) or a mature student (19 years of age or older and has been removed from full-time high school for a minimum of 2 years)
- *Students applying as mature students must demonstrate appropriate levels of math, English literacy, comprehension, and/or writing skills to warrant success and completion of the program
