ABOUT HOSPITAL:

Awasthi Ayurvedic Hospital was established in 2016 and has been serving the community with the help of professional Ayurvedic specialist doctors since its inception. It is a 60-bedded hospital equipped with all necessary facilities such as a fully functional pathology laboratory, X-ray unit, Physiotherapy Unit , pharmacy, and more. The hospital also has a well-equipped major operation theatre, a minor OT, and separate OTs for ENT and Eye care. Spacious wards, a canteen, and outpatient services (OPD) in eight departments are also available. These departments include Kayachikitsa (General Medicine), Panchakarma (Detoxification Therapy), Shalya Tantra (Surgery), Shalakya Tantra (ENT and Ophthalmology), Prasuti Tantra evam Stri Roga (Gynecology and Obstetrics), Bal Roga (Pediatrics), Vish Chikitsa (Toxicology), and Swasthavritta & Yoga (Preventive Healthcare), along with Atyayika Chikitsa (Emergency department) services. The hospital is dedicated to delivering holistic and affordable Ayurvedic care to the community.



Affiliation :-

Awasthi Ayurvedic Medical College and Hospital is affiliated with Atal Medical Research University, Mandi, Himachal Pradesh and approved by the National Council for Indian System Of Medicine (NCISM) Govt. of India.

GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS:

- A. The students must always abide by the rules and regulations of the institution.
- B. The students at any time shall not indulge in such activities which would defame the institution.

b) **Objectives:** The College, apart from serving as Institute of Teaching and Training of Ayurvedic under-graduate students, is also engaged in promotion and propagation of alternative system of medicine i.e. Ayurveda. Some of the aims and objectives of this institute are listed below:-

- b) To produce graduates who could efficiently serve in state Ayurvedic health services and also as Ayurvedic practitioners by providing relief to the patients through various therapeutic measures.
- c) To run a college hospital to provide healthcare to patients through specialists of various specialization of Ayurveda.
- d) To conduct re-orientation Training Programs for Ayurvedic teachers and Physicians as part of Continued Medical Education and to empower them with the latest advances in the field of Ayurveda and modern sciences.
- e) To disseminate information of Ayurvedic education and research through periodicals, research papers, books, seminars, symposia, workshop, camps etc. and to undertake other ancillary works for furtherance of the objectives of the institute.





HERBAL GARDEN:

The College has a herbal garden covering 2500 square meters area and more than 1150 medicinal plants representing around 250 different species from tropical and subtropical regions

LIBRARY:

A very spacious library having distinguished collection of more than 10230 books with adequate seating capacity. Along with digital library with high-speed internet connectivity is available for accessing the resources digitally and online.



HOSTEL FACILITY:

Separate hostels for boys and girls with mess facilities are available.

Computer Lab

Institute has a fully equipped computer Laboratory with Multimedia, Internet facilities. Students are encouraged to utilize it to maximum.



Pathology Lab - Pathology is a laboratory where tests are carried out on clinical specimens to obtain information about the health of a patient to aid in diagnosis, treatment and prevention of disease. This analyze blood urine and tissue samples to diagnose various diseases . Clinical pathology is further divided in to several sub specialties, such as clinical chemistry (**biochemistry**), which analyzes chemical components in the blood (e.g. enzymes, electrolytes, hormones); **hematology**, which studies blood disorders and **microbiology**, which investigates infectious agents like bacteria, viruses and fungi.



Physiology Lab - Physiology Lab serves as a crucial space where students can gain hands-on experience by conducting experiments to directly observe and analyze the function of human body's different organ systems, allowing them to deeply understand how the body works at a cellular and systemic level, typically utilizing tools like electrocardiograms (ECG'S), spirometers, calorimeter and sphygmomanometer to measure physiological parameters.



Quality control lab (Rasashastra evam bhaijsya kalpna) – This lab refers to processes by which various metals, minerals and other substances, including most notably mercury, are purified and combined with herbs in an attempt to treat illnesses. Rasashastra is a pharmaceutical branch of Indian system of medicine and a genre of literature which mainly deals with the metals, minerals, product of animal origin, toxic herbs and their use in therapeutics.



Hospital OPD's :-

1.Kayachikitsa (General Medicine)

Kayachikitsa focuses on the diagnosis and treatment of a wide range of systemic diseases. It primarily deals with imbalances in the body's metabolism (Agni), digestion, and internal medicine concerns related to dosha (Vata, Pitta, and Kapha).

2.Shalya Tantra (Surgery & Para-surgical Procedures)

ShalyaTantra is the Ayurvedic branch dedicated to surgical procedures, wound care, and para-surgical techniques such as Kshara Karma (alkaline cauterization) and Agnikarma (thermal cauterization).

3.Shalakya Tantra (ENT & Ophthalmology)

ShalakyaTantra specializes in the diagnosis and treatment of diseases related to the head, eyes, ears, nose, and throat using Ayurvedic therapies and surgical interventions

4.Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga (Gynecology & Obstetrics)

This department focuses on women's health, including pregnancy care, menstrual disorders, reproductive health, and postpartum care through natural remedies and holistic approaches.



5.Kaumara bhritya (Pediatrics & Neonatal Care)

Kaumarabhritya focuses on child healthcare, including neonatal care, immunity-boosting treatments, and the management of pediatric diseases.

6.Agada Tantra (Toxicology & Poison Management)

VishaChikitsa Outpatient (OP) Unit is designed to engage in diagnosis and treatment of animate (jangamavisha) and inanimate (sthavaravisha) poisoning, cumulative toxicity (garavisha and dooshivisha), incompatible food (viruddhaahara), alcoholism etc. Diagnosis & treatment for various skin diseases are also available

7.Panchakarma (Detoxification & Rejuvenation Therapy)

Panchakarma is Ayurveda's specialized detoxification and purification therapy that eliminates accumulated toxins (Ama) from the body and restores the balance of Doshas (Vata, Pitta, and Kapha). It is both a preventive and curative approach to overall well-being.

8.Swasthavritta (Preventive Medicine & Lifestyle Management)

Swasthavritta focuses on health promotion, disease prevention, and lifestyle modifications through Ayurveda's principles of daily (Dinacharya) and seasonal (Ritucharya) regimens. It emphasizes a holistic approach to maintaining well-being through diet, exercise, mental health, and hygiene.

Celebrating India's Ancient Healing Tradition


