# WATERCOLOR MATERIALS FOR LEVEL 1

In order to follow demonstrations and achieve similar results the following supplies will be needed

## PAINTS



Set of 10 tube watercolors paints Windsor Newton Cotman or Talens Van Gogh watercolor sets. Purchase only one of the two.

### BRUSHES



One set of short handle, synthetic watercolor brushes. The set should have at least 4 sizes of round brush and two flat brushes

## PALETTE



We will use a larger inexpensive watercolor palette to allow for more mixing space. If you use a small watercolor palette it can be used, but you may have difficulty with limited mixing space

#### WATERCOLOR PAPER



We will use Canson 140 lb cold press Watercolor paper 9" x 12". Other brands can by used by they need to be 140 lb and Cold Press.

#### MASKING FLUID/ERASER



In some lessons we will use masking fluid. Most brands work well. You will also need a kneaded eraser.

#### MASKING TAPE/RULER




You will need a roll of masking tape to tape paper to board and for creating tape boarders. Needed also is a 12" ruler.

#### CHECK FOR SIMILARITY

If you already have some of the supplies listed below please use them for the class. Make sure they are similar in kind and quality to the materials below. For instance, pan watercolors will not work for the class that is using tube waterolors

#### FOAM BOARD/NAPKINS



A foam or cardboard board is needed to hold the taped watercolor paper. Also needed is a pack of napkins for wiping the brush

# PAINTING SPONGES/WATER CUPS



A pack of watercolor sponges and two water cups for cleaning brushes during painting.

#### **NO.2 PENCIL/SHARPENER**



For marking and drawing a no. 2 pencil or HB pencil and sharpener
