# Lesson Study in practice

This Japanese approach to planning classroom based research, with the support of collegues, can be adopted in any classroom where a teacher is interested in focusing on their professional learning in practice. This template illustrates how research, action and peer feedback can be combined.

1. Set Goals

Review the overall process before adapting the approach or setting the next goal

Carefully consider lesson sequence, introduction and exit to the lesson, other variable that could impact goal and plan
