3. Genesis 22:1-13

a. Who worshipped God in this scene?

c. Why did he offer this worship?

d. What character traits did it require for him to offer this worship?

e. Note one key lesson we can learn from this scene.

What act of worship occurs in all three of these scenes?

B. Worship during the time of Moses

1. Exodus 15:1-21

- a. Who worshiped this scene?
- b. When and why were they worshipping?
- c. What act of worship is prevalent in this scene?
- d. How would you characterize the things they were saying and their behaviors as they worshipped God?
- e. Note one key lesson we can learn from this scene?

2. Exodus 19:16-25

- a. What part of this text would you consider worship?
- b. How were they to approach God?
- c. When did they approach God?
- d. Note one key lesson we can learn from this scene?

3. Exodus 12:1-14

- a. When did this act of worship occur?
- b. Why did God institute this act of worship?
- c. How specific were His instructions? {Note some of those specifics}
- d. What aspect of the character of God is demonstrated in this scene and how should we react to it?
- e. How did the people react to these instructions? (Exodus 12:26-28)
- f. Note one key lesson we can learn from this scene?

C. Worship in the days of the Priests and Kings

1. 1 Samuel 2:1-11

- a. Who was worshiping in this scene?
- b. Why were they worshiping?
- c. What act(s) of worship are present in this scene?
- d. How did they describe God as they worshipped?
- e. Note one key lesson we can learn from this scene?

2. 2 Samuel 6:12-15

- a. Who is worshiping God in this scene?
- b. Why is he worshiping?
- c. What had happened just prior to this scene?
(2 Samuel 6:5-11)
- d. How would you describe this worship?

e. Note one key lesson we can learn from this scene?

3. 1 Kings 8:22-66

a. Who is worshiping God in this scene?

b. Why is this worship taking place?

c. What common acts of worship do you see occurring?

d. What did Solomon recognize about the nature of God?
(vs. 27)

e. What specific request(s) are made toward God as they worshipped? (vs. 28-30)

f. What concern is expressed in vs. 33-37? How can the people correct the problem?

g. What posture did Solomon use as he prayed? (vs. 54)

h. How did Solomon conclude this worship of dedication at the temple? (vs. 62-66)

i. Note one key lesson we learn from the scene?
