


## **TRAIN TRAVEL**











Divide your page into four using a pencil and a ruler. These are guidelines to help you draw your train.




Use a pencil first to draw/sketch the outline, then follow with pastel/paint. Start with the front carriage on the lefthand side of the page. Draw a square to use as a guideline, then create a train carriage inside the square with a short front and taller back.




Trace some circular objects to add the wheels. Add two small wheels at the front and one larger wheel at the back.




Add more carriages. Leave a small gap behind the first carriage and add a square shape for the next carriage with 2 wheels. Repeat these steps for the next carriage.




Add a dot to the middle of each wheel.




Add roofs to the tops of the carriages. On top of the front carriage, add a chimney.




Add some windows. Add a curve to the front of the train with a small triangle at the bottom (this is the smokebox door and pilot/cowcatcher).




Add spokes to the wheels. Add window panes to the windows. Connect the carriages together with lines.



Time to add the tracks! Draw a straight horizontal line just below the wheels. Add a parallel line just behind the train. Complete the tracks with some squares below the bottom line.



Add some steam coming out the chimney.



Have fun deciding where your train is travelling and add some scenery in the background.



Time to add some color! Start by painting the background.



Add in some more colors to the smaller areas.



For extra texture and contrast add in some darker lines with a fine paintbrush.
