Sunday 19th April: “Dave’s Dawn Chorus” with our chairman Dave Sage. Meet at The Shallows car park in Saltford at 4.30am (Yes!). Please wear warm, waterproof clothes and bring binoculars. Optional donation to AWT on the day. **FFI Dave 07899 716068**

Thursday 14th May: “Walton Common” Guided walk with the Nature Reserves Officer Frankie Clinch at 10am (Wellsway School for the minibus £4 each) or 11am at this AWT Nature Reserve. Donation to AWT on the day. Please wear clothing appropriate for the weather, and sturdy shoes/boots. **FFI LIZ**

Saturday 6th June: “Deep Dive into the Downs & Avon Gorge” with Anna Stevens, Biodiversity Manager. This is a follow-up field trip from her October talk. Meet at Wellsway School at 1pm for the minibus, £3.50 each, or at 2pm at the old front entrance to Bristol Zoo Gardens, Clifton Down. Please wear appropriate clothes for the weather, and sturdy shoes or boots. Minimum £5 each to Avon Gorge Wildlife on the day. **FFI LIZ**

Saturday 27th June: “Folly Farm & its Badgers” with Nature Reserves Manager Alex Preston. This will be a late afternoon/dusk field trip, we will be taken around the farm and end up at the badgers’ sett main entrance, where we hope to see the badgers emerge! Meet at Wellsway School for the minibus, Time to be advised, £3.50 each, or at Folly Farm if travelling independently. Donation to AWT on the day. **FFI LIZ**

Thursday 23rd July: “Rewilding Watercress Farm” with Martin Williams, head of Nature Connection at the Belmont Estate. This will be a follow-up field trip to his talk in January. Meet at Wellsway School at 1pm for the minibus, cost £4.50 each, or at the Belmont Estate at 2pm. Please wear clothes appropriate for the weather, and sturdy shoes or boots. Sunday 23rd August: “Bath Riverside Ramble” with Liz Wintle exploring a new Urban Treescape trail of 1.75 miles, starting and finishing at the bus stop on James Street West. Meet at 2pm, finish before 4pm. Please wear clothes suitable for the weather; the route is along pavement or tarmac throughout. Optional donation to AWT on the day **FFI LIZ**

Saturday 26th September - “Pond Dipping at Wellsway School” for children aged under 7
