Father & Son have become the first Americans to break the Guinness World Record for the largest collection of Doctor Who memorabilia.

CHICAGOLAND, IL - October 1, 2024 - Guinness World Records has officially stated that Lee and William Thompson have broken the record for the largest collection of Doctor Who memorabilia. The father and son duo have put together a remarkable collection of items related to the renowned British science fiction series, *Doctor Who*.

There are currently just over 21,000 artifacts in the Thompsons' collection, and more are being added every day. Of the 21,000 items, the final approved number by Guinness was **7,507** items, breaking the previous record held by *Lily Connors* from the United Kingdom.

Lee Thompson remarked, "*We are thrilled to have broken this record. Our love for Doctor Who is clear in this collection, which speaks to the show's enormous impact on our lives. We are determined to honor the rich history of Doctor Who and encourage other fans to follow their own interest in it.*"

"*This journey has been incredible, and we are grateful for the support of our family, friends, and fellow Whovians,*" **William Thompson** said. "*We've added another hundred or so items since we finished counting, and we don't intend to slow down anytime soon!*"
