

## FUNDET SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

FUNDET is a private foundation committed to assist Hispanic/Latino (a) adults in obtaining a technical certificate at Salt Lake Tech, MTECH, and OTECH to prepare them to enter the workforce. The FUNDET Scholarship program is managed and directed by The FUNDET Student Leadership Council. To qualify for the scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Have the math and English skills to be admitted into the technical training program.
- Be Hispanic/Latino (a) adult interested in a technical training program.
- Upon training completion, be ready, able, and willing to enter the workforce.
- Pay between 25% or 50% of the program tuition and fees plus books and supplies.
- Maintain 90% attendance and 90% progress for the length of the program.
- Commit to 10 hours of community service a month for the length of the program.
- Attend a Monthly Progress Interview with a FUNDET program mentor.
- FUNDET mentor approves funding upon student meeting scholarship criteria.

### **FUNDET Scholarship Documentation**

The following documentation is required to complete the FUNDET Scholarship application:

1. A signed FUNDET Scholarship Application form.
2. A signed Consent to Release of Information Form (FERPA).
3. A formal picture to be printed in the FUNDET Graduation Celebration program.
4. Employment and Personal Demographics Information.
5. Two letters of recommendation.
6. Personal essay that includes your interest in the chosen training program, why you feel you deserve the scholarship, your career and employment goals.
7. A screenshot of your semester's financial participation.

By submitting this information, you will qualify for an interview with The FUNDET Scholarship Determination Committee. They will review your application, determine your award, and explain the steps that you need to take to maintain your scholarship. Please read the scholarship criteria carefully to assure that the requirements, and guidelines, are standards that you can abide by and meet your expectations. **Incomplete application could delay your award for the following semester and depending on the number of applicants you may have to go on a waiting list.**
