



# BIG BEAVER PRO-AM

Hosted by the Beaver Creek Archery Club

The Beaver Creek Archery Club in Slayton, MN hosted the 25th Annual Big Beaver Pro-Am on Saturday February 21st. Twenty elite archers from a 150-mile radius shot a 30 arrow qualifying round at a vertical 3 spot Lancaster target.

Nick Pieske was the Top Qualifier, followed by Adam Kramer, with 13-year-old William Moe close behind to lead the 10-person Pro division. Jesse Given was at the top of the Amateur division.

Shoot-offs were head-to-head Lancaster style (bottom to top) in each division with a Losers bracket. The 1.5 cm white dot was valued at 13 points and was always in play, which made for some very exciting matches.

Adam Kramer was sent to the Losers bracket by Nick Pieske, where he eliminated Adam Johnson, giving him an opportunity for a rematch with Nick. Adam needed to beat Nick twice to win the Pro division, which he did.

In the Amateur division, Nathan Wieme started third from the bottom (sandbagger) and won seven matches in a row, defeating Jesse for the Amateur division title. That set the stage for Nathan and Adam to battle for the coveted title of the Big Beaver Champion. In a closely contested match, Nathan became the first Amateur to win the Big Beaver Award.

Smack talking is encouraged before and during this shoot with the participants voting for the best smack talker. The traveling Sultan of Smack trophy was given to Nathan to hold dear for the next year.

A lot of fun was had by all, and we hope to see some more new faces next year!

# WHITE ELEPHANT SHOOT

Hosted by the Little Crow Archery Club

January 1, 2026 marked another unforgettable start to the new year at Little Crow Archery Club in Hutchinson, MN, as archers gathered for the annual White Elephant Shoot. What began as a simple idea — to create a tournament where fun mattered just as much as skill — has quickly become one of the most anticipated events of the season.

About a year ago, the concept was born: instead of competing solely for money or traditional trophies, why not host a shoot where archers could “call out” anyone they wanted and compete for white elephant gag gifts? The goal was to create an event that combined high-level competition with laughter, surprises, and a bit of friendly chaos. True to white elephant tradition, the target changes each year. For 2026, the club selected an ASA Vitals target, adding a fresh challenge to the day.

The event kicked off with a competitive money shoot featuring 27 archers. Each participant paid a \$40 entry fee and brought a wrapped white elephant gift, not fully knowing what the day had in store. Shooters traveled from all across Minnesota — Twin Cities, western, northern, and southern regions — and even included an impressive international competitor: a World Cup archer from Australia.

As the rounds progressed, competition intensified. When the final arrows were scored, four archers posted perfect 380 scores: Timothy Lopez, Matt Kargas, Adam Kramer, and Jon Paul. With such precision on display, the X-count ultimately determined placements. A tie between Adam Kramer and Matt Kargas required an additional shoot-off to decide second and third place.

Final Results:

1st Place: Timothy Lopez

2nd Place: Adam Kramer

3rd Place: Matt Kargas

Winners received oversized “Happy Gilmore” style checks, bringing both smiles and applause from the crowd. While scores were being tabulated, the lower half of competitors gathered for a giant shoot-down. In dramatic fashion, Todd Nelson and Isaac Lund advanced to the final showdown — competing for what turned out to be a beautifully decorated trophy toilet seat. The crowd erupted when Isaac claimed victory, finally revealing the mystery prize.

After placement shoot-offs were completed (ranked 1 through 27), the range opened up for open call-outs. For nearly 45 minutes, archers challenged one another freely. Good-natured heckling filled the range, and traditional line etiquette took a brief backseat to laughter and excitement.

The afternoon also featured a youth division, where parents proudly watched their children compete. Grant Gibson earned the top youth score and received a first-round bye in the shoot-down. The young archers made a strong impression, demonstrating both skill and sportsmanship.


Once the arrows were set aside, it was time for the highly anticipated white elephant gift exchange. Placement determined picking order, starting with first place. Wrapping paper quickly filled the floor as gifts were opened and traded. Among the most memorable items were a stylish hat, a bedpan, gummy nocks, and even a can of Busch Light — perfectly capturing the playful spirit of the event.

The White Elephant Shoot continues to grow as a unique way to celebrate archery and kick off the new year. Combining competitive excellence with creativity and humor, the event brings together archers of all ages and skill levels in an atmosphere that feels both welcoming and electric.

Little Crow Archery Club looks forward to continuing this tradition for years to come — and, of course, choosing an entirely new and unexpected target for 2027.



## *Stan Meyer*

### **WHERE IT ALL BEGAN**

Stan started shooting archery at the youthful age of five. Armed with suction cup arrows, he stalked the wilds of his home farm for all sorts of dangerous game. He made his own bows from tree limbs and binder lathes during his first ten years of archery. Stan purchased his first new bow, a lemonwood longbow, when he was 18 years old. He has been making most of his own bows since 1959. In the 1980's, Stan designed and handcrafted the Stan Meyer Ram Hunter recurve bow. He personally made 297 of these beautiful and very functional bows, each one of them a work of art. These bows were sold all over the world.

### **YOUTH INVOLVEMENT**

Over the years, Stan has given away bows and arrows to area youths who were not in a position to buy one. During the 1980's and 1990's, Stan mentored two young boys who had been abandoned by their dads. Stan introduced these boys to archery and provided the much-needed guidance that all young people need. He became a father to both of these boys, in a time when they needed one the most. One of them, a boy named Adam, went on to become the State Indoor Champion in his class at the age of fifteen. The other young man, Kevin, has been enjoying the sport of archery since his time growing up with Stan. In 1975, Stan's fifteen-year-old son, Tim, took first place in his division at the MSAA Indoor Championships. Sharing archery with young people has provided Stan with some of the most satisfying times in his many years of archery.

As a youth, Stan was not a confident lad. As the years past, Stan excelled in archery, and this carried over into other areas of his life. Stan says, "archery has been very good to me, and I just enjoy sharing it with others."

### **INVOLVEMENT IN THE COMMUNITY**

During the 60's, 70's and 80's, Stan and his wife Virgena, put on trick shooting demonstrations at schools, churches, Legion and Kiwanis clubs, nursing homes, and sport shows throughout West Central Minnesota. These demonstrations were put on, not for financial gain, but for the promotion of archery.

### **DETERMINATION IN SPITE OF SETBACKS**

In 1987, Stan suffered a major setback with cancer. The prognosis not good. After surgery, Stan lost 80% of the muscle in the right side of his neck and shoulder. Determined to recover and go on with life, Stan is here today, to share his friendship with friends throughout the archery community. He credits his recovery to determination, a positive attitude, and a very large helping hand from God. Try telling Stan what a lousy day it is, and he will tell you that it is a beautiful day.

After his bout with cancer, he cherishes everyday he can spend with family and friends.

## **SUCCESS OVER THE YEARS**

In the late 1980's and early 1990's, due to his go round with cancer, Stan went to shooting a compound bow in the MS4A adaptive division. In this division, Stan set 18 new MSAA records and took 17 first place awards in Field round, 900 round, and 3D rounds.

Stan has been competing in archery in the state of Minnesota for over 50 years. He started out shooting traditional equipment for forty-nine years, then due to cancer, Stan shot a compound bow for seven years, then he went back to his favorite, traditional equipment these past eight years. He has been enjoying archery for sixty-four years, and he continues to do so. Hopefully, sharing with friends for many more years to come.


