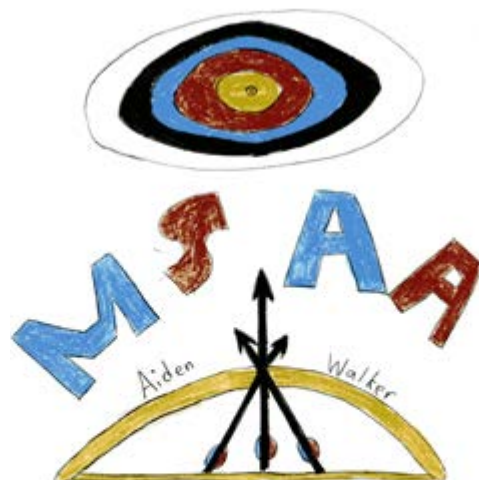


## MSAA ARTIST FEATURE AIDEN WALKER

# Minnesota Archery Hall of Fame

## Mary & Harold Buckentin



You can't speak of Mary and Harold Buckentins' archery accomplishments without recalling the early days of the Chilakoot Bowhunters. This is really the only way to understand how this couple put their hearts and souls into creating an organization that has been an integral part of the local archery and hunting community for 70 years.

In 1953, a group of 23 archers who'd been shooting their bows in backyards and basements got together and formed the Chilakoot Bowhunters. Mary and Harold were part of that group. One of the members donated the use of his land where a 14-target range was established. Weekends and evenings were spent cutting trails, placing hay bales as butts, hand painting animal targets, etc. Soon their first outdoor tournaments were held.

The Buckentins went on to be regulars at all local and MSAA tournaments both indoors and out for several decades. Because of their club involvement, Chilakoot Bowhunters was selected "Club of the Month" in November 1961 by the NFAA and a nice article was published about them in Archery Magazine.

The club shot indoors at several places over the years including the basement of Washington School, the Stillwater caves, the recreation hall above the Playmore Bowling Lanes and the basement of the Stillwater Police station. Mary and Harold never missed Tuesday evening club nights. It was obvious the Chilakoot's needed an indoor range of their own. As members of the board of directors, Mary and Harold were part of the decision process to set aside a percentage

from all public shoots to create a building fund. They knew that in order to attract members and grow as a club it was important to have a facility to allow members to shoot indoors. In 1991 that dream was realized as indoor leagues were finally held in their own building.

Family activities were important to them, and they encouraged club events that brought all members together such as awards banquets, corn feeds, float trips, Christmas parties and even spaghetti dinners. Their influence in the promotion of archery is immeasurable and has spanned decades of club involvement. Without them the club would not have been able to sustain its incredibly rich and long history.

During the late 50's and early 60's while modern archery was still in its youth, Mary and Harold helped to organize regular archery clinics. This included youth classes which they helped to organize and teach which later warranted an article published in the St. Paul Pioneer Press that helped to easily recruit 100 children a year to participate in these archery classes. Instructions were designed to first teach safety, shooting rules and responsibility. Later focus was on style, form, practice, and finally competitive shooting. It is difficult to calculate how many of these young archers went on to pursue archery and bowhunting with the same enthusiasm the Buckentins' conveyed through their teaching, but many became and are still members today.

Through all this, they also bow hunted for as long as their health and age allowed. Antelope, deer, bear, rabbits, and turkeys were all hunted with passion. Mary took the largest buck in camp when she was 71 years old. Over the years, Mary and Harold shared camp stories to an untold number of young hunters passing on their passion for bowhunting to a new generation. Because of their involvement, the Chilakoot Bowhunters club has remained a constant influence in the community and is home to one of Minnesota's oldest and continuously active archery clubs, and certainly one of the biggest and best privately owned archery clubs anywhere. Both sat on the Chilakoot Bowhunters Board of Directors multiple times. Harold was club president in 1957, 1958, 1968 and 1972. Mary held the treasurers position many times over the years. Both won the prestigious Chilakoot Board of Directors Award – Mary in 1967 and Harold in 1969. They were both awarded the Chilakoot Lifetime Achievement Award in 2018.

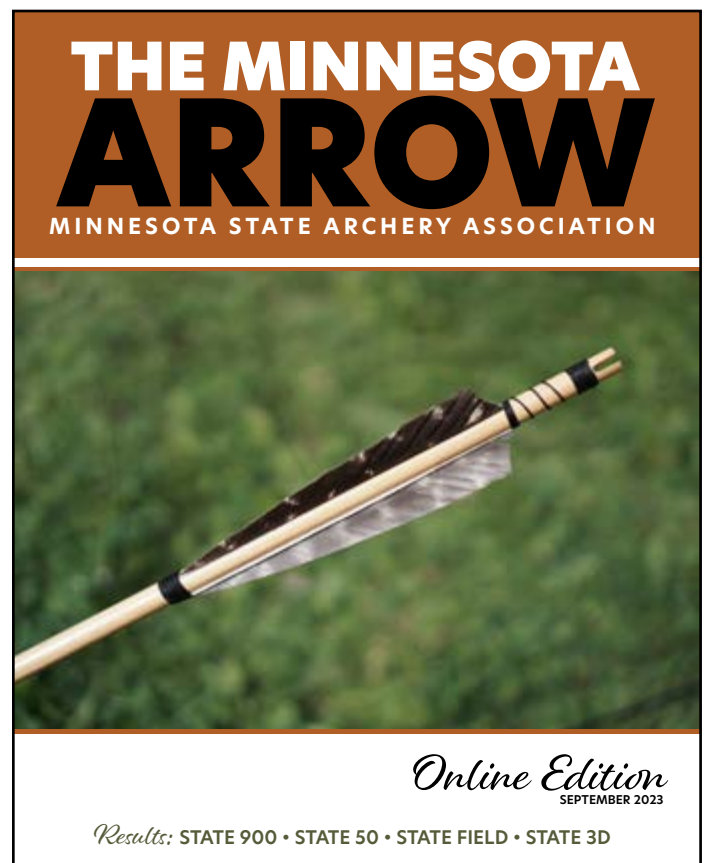
