MSAA BOWFISHING TOURNAMENT

I. Dates

- **A.** Dates to be decided by the Board of Directors (1/03/04).
- B. All dates shall conform to Minnesota Law

II. Registration

- **A.** No pre-registration needed
- **B.** A team consists of two registered persons. Spectators are allowed. (1/08/05)
- C. Host club to handle registration, collect fees and handle new MSAA memberships
- **D.** Contestants must be MSAA members. Non-members may join at the time of registration.
- E. All participants must conform to all boating and game laws
- **F.** MSAA shall set tournament fee reference p.32
- **G.** No alcoholic beverages to be consumed by team members during tournament

III. Fish

- **A.** All rough fish are to be legal
- **B.** Bowfishing area to be set up by host club

IV. The host club shall handle weigh-In

A. The host club shall determine weigh in time. Latecomers will be deducted 3 pounds per minute late, per boat.

- **B.** Late more than 1/2 hour will result in disqualification
- **C.** Largest and smallest fish weighed
- **D.** Winners to be determined by total weight. The host club shall determine maximum number of fish (1/08/05).

V. Awards

- **A.** Awards to be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
- **B.** Each team member to be given award
- **C.** 1st place for largest fish
- D. Smallest fish (Minnow) award

VI. Responsibilities of MSAA

- A. Make opening announcement (rules, etc.)
- **B.** Determine dates
- **C.** Determine site by bidding process
- **D.** Provide all awards
- **E.** Advertise tournament in Arrow
- **F.** Provide \$8.00 per team to host club
- **G.** Publish final results in Arrow

VII. Responsibilities of Host Club

- **A.** Handle registration and handle new MSAA memberships
- **B.** Handle weigh-in
