## **Minutes of the Minnesota State Archery Association**

### **Meeting of May 11th, 2020**

President Kyle Aho called the meeting to order at 8:04 PM. Those present were: Todd Nelson, Joe Zimmerman, Paul Parsons, Tom Rose, Roger Ekert, Dean Summer, John Steinle, Mike Vertina, Stephanie Wiseman, and Kyle Aho

Kyle A. started by saying we need a larger meeting soon, but we needed to talk about the state target and what we should do there first. He also mentioned that Zoom has a 40-minute time limit with the free version. There was some discussion about paying monthly for Zoom to extend the meeting time limit.

Paul P. made a motion to purchase zoom monthly for future meetings. Todd N seconded – Motion approved.

There was discussion on if we cancel the Start Target should we cancel the other two since we are already down two tournaments for the year. Joe Z. mentioned that Todd N. was waiting on an answer from the governor and the board before making a decision.

Tom R. mentioned that he feels the governor is going to extend the stay at home order. Because of all of this even if they are going to have the shoot there is going to be less people showing up. If they don't extend the stay at home order and they can host the tournament there would still be CDC guidelines to follow including masks, etc. Tom R. feels that the MSAA has a responsibility to make sure someone doesn't get infected at one of the tournaments. He feels that we as the MSAA should just close down for the year and open back up in 2021.

Kyle A. agreed that the shooting would be difficult with all of the guidelines, etc. Todd N. mentioned that it is a little disappointing and that it would be a little safer to hold the shoots since they are outside. There was additional discussion on how many people would actually attend if they held the shoot and how would they run the shoots when people have to stay 6 feet apart, etc.

Todd N. made a motion to cancel the State Target and 50 Meter shoot but leave the rest open at this point. John S. seconded – Motion approved.

The State Field and State 3D shoot will be addressed at a later date.

Tom R. wanted to make sure that the announcement for the shoot cancelation is made to the website at the top of the page in red letters if possible. Kyle A. will write something up and get it to Joe Z. to post on the website.

Discussion was had about making the zoom meeting public or who should be invited to the meeting. Kyle A. mentioned maybe sending the invite to the club presidents and not posting on the website. Most agreed that it should not be opened to the public.

**Next meeting** – Will be on June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2020 at 6:30 PM via Zoom.

**MEETING ADJOURNED** – Todd N. made a motion to adjourn, Mike V. seconded – Meeting adjourned

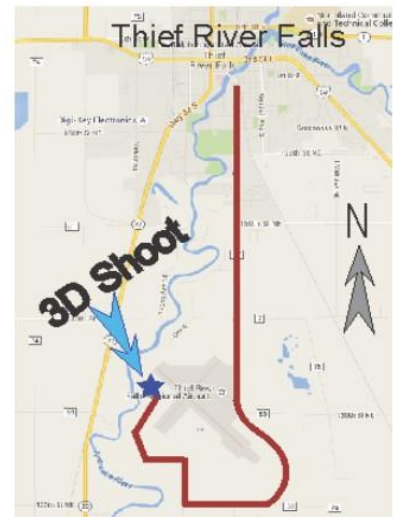
