Tournament Format:

- Game Format: Best-of-3 2 deck, Swiss format. Online
- Round Time Limit: Until the last game finishes
- Deck Requirements: Non-restricted cards only
- Entry Fee: \$15 or Free to All, Monthly \$20 Entry

Format:

Game Type: 1v1

Structure: Swiss

• Match Format: Best-of-3 (2-Deck Format)

• Platform: Shadowverse: Worlds Beyond (Online)

Deck Rules

- Each player must bring 2 different decks.
- Both decks must use different leaders (no duplicate leaders).
- Players cannot change decks once the tournament begins.
- **Decks must be registered** before the event starts (if required by organizer).

Match & Round Timing

No in-game time limits.



All In One Gaming Generation, LLC Competitive Event Rules

- Each round continues until all matches are finished.
- Players must be **available and responsive** in the tournament communication channel (e.g., Discord).
- Players taking excessive time or being AFK may be given a match loss at the organizer's discretion.

🔁 Match Procedure

- 1. Players start by selecting one of their two decks to begin the match.
- 2. The loser of a game must switch to their second deck.
- 3. The winner of a game must stay on the winning deck.
- 4. First player of each game is determined randomly by the game.

Reporting Results

- Match winners must report the score to a tournament admin or via the designated reporting system (e.g., match-report channel or tournament bot).
- If there's a dispute, screenshots or video proof are recommended.

Additional Rules

- Players must be respectful and follow all community guidelines.
- **Disconnects/crashes** will result in a **game loss** unless both players agree to a rematch.
- Any form of cheating, unsportsmanlike behavior, or stream sniping will result in disqualification.

• Tournament organizer decisions are final.

Prizes & Standings

- Prizing will be based on final Swiss standings or a Top Cut if specified before the event.
- Ties in standings will be broken by standard Swiss tiebreakers (e.g., Opponent Match Win %).
