Course Content

The Teacher Training Course is a part time Progressive Framework in Steiner Pedagogy at Primary level with additional content on Early Years and Second Level. Course 1 is an introduction "Education for our Time" formerly "Core Elements of Steiner Education" Course 2 is a more intensive immersion "To the Heart of Steiner Education", (see below) Course 3 "Resolve, Resilience & Readiness is an intensive immersion and includes student projects/research, teacher development, the contemporary child and teaching in the 21st Century.


"To the Heart of Steiner Education" will run across the calendar year 2026 over 7 weekends plus 2 x 5 day blocks out of term time, and builds on the foundation provided by Core Elements of Steiner Education. We will cover the curriculum in greater depth through having themed weekends and blocks that show how each subject/theme develops as the child unfolds through the different ages. There will be ongoing study of key texts by Rudolf Steiner, giving the developmental picture of the human being in all its complexity and wonder. All sessions are rooted in illustrating the practicality and wisdom to be found in the understanding of the human being in the light of anthroposophy. They combine to offer an integrated whole that will develop an understanding of the philosophy and practices of the Steiner Primary school curriculum and its applications. Additional content is included on early years and second level education to create a whole and rounded picture and to meet the diverse needs and expressed interests of participants. Facilitated reflective practice, peer networking, mentoring and group work, brings the additional richness and benefits of colleagueship. Seminars will be led by Nell Smyth and a diverse group of specialist tutors. Small group peer mentoring sessions with specialist teachers according to the interests and needs of the participants will remain a key element, as will the exploration of our own unique perspectives as a key task for a teacher.

The thematic areas we will cover are maths, movement, art, craft, class trip, literacy, drama and class plays, music, science, additional needs.

Caroline Kelly - Was one of the founders of the ALFA Project (now Alfa Steiner Secondary School), where she teaches 12- 18 year olds, and is one of the core group of lead teachers. She was formerly the Director of the Waldorf College for 16–19 year olds in the UK.
