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# Corner 2 Corner (C2C) Crochet



## **Abbreviations:**

ch - chain  
ch-sp - chain space  
rep - repeat  
sl st - slip stitch  
st(s) - stitch(es)  
tr - treble

## What is Corner 2 Corner Crochet?

**Corner to Corner (C2C) Crochet** is a technique worked diagonally, creating small blocks (tiles) that build up a design

**Basic Tile:** Work 6 chain sts, 1 treble into fourth chain st from hook, 1 treble into next 2 chain sts (3tr sts)

**Increasing:** Work 6 ch, 1tr into fourth ch from hook, 1 tr into next 2ch sts, turn block(s), slip st into the previous tile, 3ch, 3tr into 3ch-sp.

**Decreasing:** Sl st across the top sts, sl st into 3ch-sp, \*work 3 ch, 3tr into 3ch-sp; rep from \* to end of row, fasten off.

**Reading a chart:** Start at the bottom corner and work diagonally. Each square represents one tile.

**Colour changes:** On the last yarn over of the final treble stitch, introduce the new colour and continue according to your chart.

**Mindset reminder:** Progress over perfection - practice makes progress and repetition builds confidence!



# Increasing:



Work 6 chain sts



1tr into fourth ch from hook



1tr into next 2 ch sts (1 tile made)



Work 6 chain sts



1tr into fourth ch from hook



1tr into next 2 ch sts (1 tile made)



Turn block(s)



Slip stitch into previous block, chain 3



Work 3 tr into 3ch-sp

# Decreasing:



Slip stitch across top of last block



Work 3 chain sts



Work 3 tr sts into 3ch-sp



Join with a sl st
